Technical Appendix

Technical Appendix

- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 917 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.
- Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 1st 12th October, 2016.
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socioeconomic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



Technical Appendix

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish
 their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They
 also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how
 people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one
 we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.








Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown (excluding undecided/adjusted)






Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided - Adjusted)



Support for Introduction of Abortion






Would you be in favour or opposed to the introduction of abortion in Ireland in circumstances



Commentary

Background

Fieldwork for last month's poll was conducted against the backdrop of quite a busy political August and September, with a range of issues likely to have influenced the slight drop in support for Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael, and corresponding uplift for Sinn Féin and the Labour Party.

In the four weeks since that survey, we witnessed the resolution of the Dublin Bus strike, and the on-going dialogue around the likely content of the forthcoming budget.

It is fair to say that expectations as to what the budget might bring (with fieldwork for today's poll all but complete prior to its announcement) were quite well managed by both the Fine Gael/Independent coalition, but also by Fianna Fáil as it postured from the sidelines.

With the Fiscal Advisory Council warning of the need for a cautious budget in the wake of Brexit in particular, the overarching message from the powers that be was to expect a budget with only modest improvements to the electorate's personal finances, albeit one which would clearly mark the end of the long string of austerity cuts.

Indeed, much of the narrative spun by the Government related to likely measures to help first time buyers, and at least some investment in health, education and state pension payments.

As such, the prevailing mood of the electorate seemed a little more upbeat than it had been in the immediate run up to budgets over the last few years, with at least some reason to believe that we might be on the cusp of a meaningful economic recovery.



Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

An overview of party leader satisfaction ratings confirms that, at 48% satisfaction, Micheál Martin remains the most popular political leader in the country by quite some margin.

Brendan Howlin's satisfaction rating as leader of the Labour Party has slipped a further three points on last month's showing, to 36% today. In fairness to Howlin, his poll ratings over the last four months or so since he assumed leadership of the party stood at in or around 40%, and his rating of 36% today is more a function of his honeymoon period having worn off, than anything else.

Enda Kenny's rating as Taoiseach has slipped 4 points to 29% - a little higher than his standing in the immediate aftermath of last February's General Election, but a long way off his high of 47% in 2012.

At a party level, support for Fianna Fáil is up 2 points in today's poll to 30%, and Fine Gael is up 3 points to 26%. This confirms the pattern established in the polling series six months ago, whereby Fianna Fáil is relatively firmly established as the most popular party in the country, followed by Fine Gael at a modest but consistent distance.

As the two establishment parties consolidate their positions at the top, support for Sinn Féin, Labour and the Independents and smaller parties has slipped back, to varying degrees.

When the various strands of the above dynamics are drawn together, it is clear that there has been a fundamental shift towards both Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael, and away from Labour and Independents/smaller parties, within the classic 'squeezed middle' constituency.

To be precise, Fianna Fáil support has increased 8 percentage points over the last four weeks amongst the 'middle class' ABC1 socio economic category, while Fine Gael has improved 3 points in the same category. We see the same improvements for both of the two main parties in Dublin (Fianna Fáil up 4 points, Fine Gael up 7 points), and urban areas in general (Fianna Fáil up 5 points, Fine Gael up 2 points).

Conversely, we see support for both the Labour Party and, even more dramatically, Independents/Others drop in exactly these same demographic groupings. Specifically, Labour support is down 4 points amongst ABC1s, while Independents/Others are down a massive 11% in the same cohort. Similarly, Labour is down 5 points in Dublin, with Independents/Others down 8% in the capital.

This is the first time in many years that we have witnessed Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael both increase their support amongst precisely the same section of the electorate at the same time.

The message here is clear – voters are indeed beginning to return to the larger, long-established parties in favour of smaller parties and Independents in particular, as they begin to sense that real economic recovery is underway.

A closer analysis of the type of Independent/Other candidates which have lost support in recent weeks supports this analysis.

Thus, in today's poll support for the Social Democrats has collapsed to 0, Renua Ireland is down to just 1%, and support for the Independent Alliance has plunged from 6% to just 1% amongst the middle class ABC1s.

Support for Sinn Féin remains solid month-on-month at 17%, although it has dropped 5 percentage points amongst the over 55s, and 6 points in rural areas.

Today's poll may herald the emergence of a realignment in Irish politics in advance of the next election – i.e. Sinn Féin and left-leaning Independents battling for the left of centre vote, Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael competing head to head for middle Ireland, with Labour relentlessly squeezed in between.



Repeal of the Eighth Amendment

According to today's poll, the vast majority of those expressing an opinion are in favour of a repeal of the Eighth Amendment. The actual figures are 59% in favour of a repeal of the Eighth Amendment, 23% opposed to a repeal and 18% undecided.

These figures would be in line with those of similar polls conducted in the recent past, and suggest that a strong majority would be inclined towards supporting a repeal of the amendment, although this is of course before the ins and outs of the debate have been fully aired as they would be during the course of an actual Referendum campaign.

In general, younger, middle class urban dwellers are more likely to support an appeal of the amendment, as are supporters of Sinn Féin, Independents, and smaller parties.

Today's poll also repeated a number of questions designed to measure support or opposition to the introduction of abortion in Ireland in various circumstances, which have been asked on a series of polls stretching back to 2013.

The response to these questions shows no material difference in voter opinion over the years. Specifically, around three-quarters of the electorate is in favour of the introduction of abortion in circumstances where fatal foetal abnormality means the baby cannot survive, with circa 70% in favour of the introduction of abortion in circumstances where the pregnancy results from rape or incest.



Repeal of the Eighth Amendment

There has been a subtle shift in support for the introduction of abortion in more general circumstances (as it is in Britain, for example). While a third of all voters are in favour of abortion in general circumstances, the percentage opposed to it has dropped from 57% last year to 50% today. The balance of opinion has in fact shifted into the undecided camp, which has increased from 9% last July to 15% now.
