#### **Introduction**

### Background & Objectives

- RTÉ/BBC NI wished to carry out a survey amongst adults living on the Island of Ireland.
- The purpose of the survey was to provide up-to-date, Island of Ireland data, on attitudes to a broad range of social and current affairs issues.

#### Methodology

- A face-to-face survey was carried out, with quotas set on gender, age and social class within region, to ensure the results correctly reflect the known demographics of the Republic of Ireland (based on latest CSO data) and Northern Ireland (based on latest NISRIA data).
- Interviewing took place at 168 sampling points in total, 84 in the Republic and 84 in the North. A randomly generated start address was issued for each sampling point, with interviewers adopting a random rate procedure from that point.
- A total of 2,041 interviews were conducted; 1,029 in the Republic and 1,012 in the North.
- All interviewing was carried out by fully trained and supervised field interviewers, strictly adhering to AIMRO, MRS and ESOMAR opinion polling guidelines.

#### **Timing**

 Fieldwork took place simultaneously on both sides of the border, from the 2<sup>nd</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> October 2015.








- 1. Satisfaction with home life has the greatest influence on satisfaction with 'life as a whole': more pronounced in the Republic than in the North.






























































Identification with a religion higher near the Border.












## Demographics of those identifying as Northern Irish (penetration)








