Technical Appendix

Technical Appendix

- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 915 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 2nd 10th October, 2017.
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socioeconomic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



Technical Appendix

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.






Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided – Adjusted)

Commentary

Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted between Monday 2nd, to Tuesday 10th October.

As such, public discourse was very much dominated by the forthcoming budget, with the General expectation in advance of its announcement being that most people would benefit, albeit to an insignificant extent.

By the time fieldwork had commenced, most of the main political parties had also held their annual think-ins, although the media coverage of them was quite modest, and they were unlikely to have had a significant impact on the results of today's opinion poll.

At a broader level, the Brexit debate, and specifically how Brexit will affect Ireland and its economy, continued to gather pace, with a leaked Government report suggesting the effects of Irish cross-border trade are likely to be greater than initially envisaged.

Nevertheless, national and international reports continued to confirm that Ireland's economy is continuing to improve, with growth of circa 4% for 2017 forecast.

The message received by the general public over the last number of months has thus been that the years of austerity are most likely behind us, with modest improvements in our financial wellbeing likely over the next number of years.



Background

From a party political perspective Fine Gael, and Taoiseach Leo Varadkar in particular, appeared to have taken a decision to target Sinn Féin directly, and the possibility of a Fianna Fáil/Sinn Féin coalition indirectly, in a series of heated Dáil exchanges.

With all parties in a state of effective preparedness for an early 2018 election, we can expect such inter-party squabbling to intensify from now until the end of the year.



Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Last month's Behaviour & Attitudes/Sunday Times poll was a good one for Fine Gael.

Government satisfaction was up two points since the last poll before that, Leo Varadkar's personal satisfaction rating leaped from 43% to 49%, and support for Fine Gael increased to 33% — the highest level of support for that party since May 2012.

In today's poll, there has been little significant change in satisfaction levels with the various party leaders.

Satisfaction with Micheál Martin as leader of Fianna Fáil has dropped three percentage points to 50% this month, although this is not a statistically significant change.

Nor is the drop of two percentage points in Gerry Adams' satisfaction rating as leader of Sinn Féin to 38%, although this month's rating is a long way adrift from the circa 50% Adams had been achieving three and four years ago.

Brendan Howlin's rating has declined by a significant four percentage points to 40% today, although this is in or around the average score he has achieved since he was elected leader of the Labour Party.

Finally, Fine Gael will be pleased that Leo Varadkar has maintained his high satisfaction rating at 50% in this month's poll, up one percentage point since last month, and a seven percentage point increase on his first ever opinion poll rating last July.



Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

The Taoiseach's satisfaction rating is particularly high amongst those aged 55 years+ (66%), white collar and professional workers (58%) and those living in Dublin (57%) and Connaught/Ulster (56%).

Party-wise, the landscape remains very consistent with that prevailing four weeks ago – with support for Fianna Fáil increasing insignificantly from 25% to 27%, Fine Gael decreasing marginally from 33 to 31%, and the Labour Party slipping from 5 to 4% — again a statistically insignificant change.

The disproportionately higher level of support for Fine Gael in rural versus urban areas registered last month has now evened out, and the party is now neck and neck with Fianna Fáil in the Dublin area.

Al in all, Fine Gael support is actually very well spread across the different regions and demographic groupings — a phenomenon which bodes well for a party seeking to maximise its vote across all constituency types and sizes.

Although highly unlikely to enter into a pre-election pact, Fianna Fáil is certainly strongly positioned to consider forming a coalition with Sinn Féin following the next election.

At a combined 46% level of support the two parties would comfortably win a majority in the next Dáil between them, with Fianna Fáil of course in the driving seat.

Indeed, there is evidence from today's poll that these two parties will be targeting different voter cohorts come election day. For example, support for Sinn Féin peaks at 30% amongst all 18–34 year olds, yet is at its highest level for Fianna Fáil amongst 55 years plus voters, at 34%.

Similarly, Fianna Fáil is currently attracting the support of 25% of all ABC1 (middle class) voters, a grouping which Sinn Féin is particularly weak in, at just 14%.

Meanwhile, the Labour Party currently sits at just 4% of the national vote, although its support stands at 6% of all ABC1s and 5% of all voters living in urban areas.

Green Party support also peaks amongst certain types of voters (e.g. 35-54 year old family stage voters, ABC1 middle class voters) — a typical dynamic for a party which tends to perform well in specific individual constituencies, rather than at a broad national level.

We now have a battle royale on our hands as we enter what could be the closing months of the current administration.

Already we have two clear post-election scenarios — a Fianna Fáil/Sinn Féin administration, or a good old-style rainbow coalition incorporating Fine Gael, the Labour Party, Green Party, Independent Alliance and Social Democrats.



Irish National Anthem – Proficiency and Preference

This month's Social Themes question related to the public's knowledge of the Irish national anthem, and the extent to which they feel it should be mandatory to learn it in school, and/or whether we should have a new national anthem altogether.

With regard to our knowledge of the words of our anthem, 4 in 10 of all Irish adults claim they know all of its words, just under half (46%) know some of its words, while 14% (or half a million of us in total) are prepared to admit that they do not know any of the words at all.

Those claiming to know all of the words of the national anthem tend to be older, more highly educated, urban dwellers.

Perhaps surprisingly, the vast majority of voters (82%) believe it should be mandatory to learn the national anthem in school, and this is as true for those who know few or none of the words as it is amongst those who claim to know all of them.

Finally, it is safe to say that the Irish public is more than happy with the national anthem as it stands, with just one in ten of all adults (albeit rising to 17% of Dubliners!) of the view that we should have a new national anthem altogether.
