Technical Appendix

Technical Appendix

- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 955 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.2 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.
- Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 31st Jan 8th February, 2017
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socioeconomic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



Technical Appendix

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish
 their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They
 also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how
 people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one
 we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.





Commentary

Background

The general political climate over the four weeks since last month's Behaviour and Attitudes/Sunday Times Poll has been reasonably subdued.

The mood of both the electorate and the body politic appears to be one of trepidation as we wait to see what effect the likes of Brexit and the Trump Election will have on Ireland's economy, and our own personal wellbeing.

The Government continues to plod along in an unremarkable fashion, failing to engage with the general public at any meaningful level.

Indeed, it is fair to say that the overarching political narrative in Ireland has been dominated by the remarkable actions of the Trump administration as it embarked on its first three weeks in office.

Indeed, the only meaningful public debate in recent weeks seems to have been around the questions as to whether An Taoiseach Enda Kenny should visit the White House on St. Patrick's Day this year, and/or whether he should invite President Trump to visit Ireland at some stage in the future.

Last month's poll saw drops in support for the Government, Fine Gael, and Enda Kenny as Taoiseach.

For the sixth poll in a row, Fianna Fáil had beaten Fine Gael into second place in terms of popular support.

At the other end of the spectrum, Sinn Féin's vote continued to soften, while support for unaligned Independents increased six percentage points to a total of 15%.

Since then, Enda Kenny's refusal to rule out a potential future Fine Gael/Sinn Féin coalition raised more than a few eyebrows, and ignited speculation as to how far beyond this summer Kenny can last as leader of his party.

Today's is quite a worrying poll for Fine Gael. The party's support has now slid for the third month in a row, with its current 21% support level equalling Fine Gael's all-time low in the entire series, previously registered in April 2014. The party's support is now five full percentage points lower than the 26% of the first preference vote it captured in last year's General Election. If this support was replicated in a General Election scenario, the party could lose as many as 15 seats, leaving it in a near-impossible position to form a subsequent Government.

Support for Fine Gael is particularly low amongst 18-54 year old voters (16%), and in the Munster region (17%). However, Enda Kenny's personal satisfaction rating is still rock solid amongst the Fine Gael party faithful, 78% of whom are happy with the way he is doing his job as Taoiseach.

If Fine Gael's performance as main coalition partner has been unremarkable, Fianna Fáil as leader of the main opposition party has hardly been inspiring, and seems to have assumed the mantle of most popular party in the country by sheer default.

Perhaps Micheál Martin also realised that the party could do with an injection of adrenaline, with the recruitment of Stephen Donnelly to the ranks certainly causing a stir.

Whatever about the effect of this development on Donnelly's credibility amongst his Wicklow base, it will be interesting to see if Martin has any more surprises up his sleeve as he considers the most opportune moment to precipitate a general election.

Based upon the findings of today's poll, that moment could arrive sooner rather than later.

At a personal satisfaction level, Micheál Martin's rating of 53% this February is the highest the Fianna Fáil leader has achieved since the B&A/Sunday Times polling series began.

Martin's satisfaction peaks at 63% amongst those aged 55 years plus, 58% in his home province of Munster, 87% amongst Fianna Fáil supporters and, interestingly, 55% within the Fine Gael party support base.

Even more encouragingly for the Soldiers of Destiny, support for Fianna Fáil has also reached an historical high, with 32% of the Electorate now indicating that they would give their first preference vote to the party if there was a General Election tomorrow.

Support for Fianna Fáil is evenly balanced across the different socio-economic groupings, urban versus rural areas, and indeed males versus females. A performance of this magnitude in an actual General Election would place Fianna Fáil in a very strong position to form a stable Coalition Government, most likely without the need to involve Sinn Féin.

The most profound political developments on the island over the last number of weeks have actually related to Sinn Féin.

Michelle O'Neill's coronation as the new Sinn Féin leader in Northern Ireland is historical insofar as it heralds the changing of the guard from the Adam's/McGuinness axis, to the next generation.

By all accounts, it is only a matter of time before Gerry Adams is replaced as leader in the South, and it will be fascinating to see how the party fares in the forthcoming elections both in North and South of the border.

If the party did manage to garner a 19% share of the first preference vote, as indicated in today's poll, it would most likely return in or around 30 TDs to the next Dáil.

Indeed, we may be faced with a post-election scenario whereby Fianna Fáil leads the next Government, with Sinn Féin emerging as the main opposition party, ahead of Fine Gael!



President Donal J Trump

To say that the election of Donal Trump as president of the US came as a surprise, not least to the opinion pollsters, is to understate matters.

Since his inauguration, President Trump has continued to make waves with the signing of a whole raft of directives in his first few weeks in office, practically all of which have been enormously controversial.

Since the announcement of the immigration travel ban from a number of muslim majority countries, there have been clamours in Ireland for the Taoiseach to refuse to travel to the White House on St Patrick's Day this year, and also to refuse to invite Trump on an official visit to Ireland.

As far as the Electorate is concerned, these are two quite different questions.

Thus, six in ten of all Irish voters are of the view that the Taoiseach should visit the White House this St Patrick's Day, presumably on the basis of the benefits that maintaining the annual tradition will have for Ireland.

A third of the Electorate feel that Kenny should not make the trip this year, a proportion which rises to 37% in the Dublin area. A majority of supporters of all parties and political groupings are in favour of a White House trip, with the notable exception of Sinn Féin supporters, 47% of whom support the notion of a visit, and 49% of whom are opposed to it.



President Donal J Trump

While it is clearly acceptable for the Taoiseach to visit the new president to see what he can manage to extract from him for Ireland Inc., we are not so keen on the notion of having Trump pay a return visit to Ireland.

In fact, a majority of Irish voters (56%) believe Trump should not be invited to Ireland, 36% feel he should be, with one in ten of us unsure.

Given his track record on equality issues, it is probably not surprising that the strongest opposition to a Trump visit emanates from Irish women, almost two thirds of whom would not extend an invitation.
