Technical Appendix

Technical Appendix

- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 921 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.
- Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 3rd 16th January, 2016.
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socioeconomic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



Technical Appendix

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish
 their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They
 also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how
 people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one
 we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.





Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown (excluding undecided/adjusted)



Perceived percentage of Irish Population born outside Ireland x Party Support



Commentary

Background

In December's end-of-year poll, we saw a slight dip in support for both Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael, with a corresponding uplift for Sinn Féin and the Green Party.

None of these differences was statistically significant, and the reality was that Fianna Fáil remained the most popular party in the country, and had held that position for five consecutive months.

Meanwhile the combined support of Independent candidates and smaller parties seemed to have settled in at around the 20% mark, down from the 25% that bloc had achieved in the February 2016 General Election.

The conclusions drawn were the same as those we had made in analysing all of our polls in recent months – while Fianna Fáil would likely gain seats in the event of another General Election, there was no guarantee that it would lead to the formation of a Government any more stable than the current one.

The political landscape has of course been relatively quiet over the last four weeks in the lead up to today's poll with the Dáil, and indeed most of the country, on its Christmas break.

Domestically, the occupation of Apollo House, and the debate it sparked around Ireland's housing and homelessness problems, dominated media discourse.



Background

The notion of ordinary activists taking matters into their own hands and attempting to solve a problem the Government is ultimately responsible for, seemed to have captured the public's imagination, and highlighted the lack of progress made by the Government on this front.

Meanwhile, consumer confidence remained under pressure as the economic effects of both Brexit in the UK and Trump's imminent presidency in the US are far from clear.

All in all therefore, the social and political context within which today's poll was taken can be described as volatile at best, and we see this uncertainty manifest itself in a significant increase in support for smaller parties and independents on the one hand, and a drop in support for Fine Gael on the other.



Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

As recently as ten or fifteen years ago, as much attention was paid to Government and party leader satisfaction levels as it was to party support figures.

In those days, there tended to be a clear and direct correlation between the popularity of the leader of a particular party, and the level of support his/her party garnered.

For example, in his heyday, Bertie Ahern's satisfaction rating as Taoiseach hovered in or around the 70% mark, and once it remained at that level, Fianna Fáil support was almost guaranteed to have breached the 40% mark. It is a fact that once John Bruton's satisfaction rating as Taoiseach dropped to around the 30% mark, a successful leadership heave was initiated against him.

Perhaps it is an indication of an increasingly sophisticated electorate, but voters seem less concerned in recent years with the performance of individual members of Government and leaders of opposition parties, and more exercised by the collective performance of the Government and its constituent parties.

Despite all of the aforementioned, Enda Kenny will not be particularly happy with his current satisfaction rating of just 29%. While 68% of grassroots Fine Gael supporters are happy with the way Kenny is doing his job as Taoiseach, this compares relatively poorly with the corresponding proportion of Labour voters who are happy with Brendan Howlin's leadership (79%), Micheál Martin's satisfaction rating of 88% amongst core Fianna Fáil voters, and the 82% of Sinn Féin supporters who are satisfied with the way Gerry Adams is doing his job as leader of that party.



Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

The fact that Enda Kenny's satisfaction rating has dropped four percentage points since last month's poll will only be of concern to Fine Gael insofar as it coincides with a dip of three percentage points in Fine Gael party support over the same period, and indeed a drop of five percentage points since November of last year.

In the February 2016 General Election, Fine Gael captured 26% of the first preference vote, closely followed by Fianna Fáil on 24%.

The average party support figure for Fianna Fáil over the last six months stands at 29%, with the corresponding figure for Fine Gael registering at 25%.

Given that Fianna Fáil has in recent years consistently out-performed its opinion poll ratings in actual elections by as many as two to three percentage points, it would not be beyond the realms of possibility that Fianna Fáil could capture between 32% and 35% of the first preference vote if they precipitated a General Election over the next number of months.

If they did, the party could be sitting on between 50 and 55 seats in the next Dáil, needing another 25 or 30 to form a viable coalition, precisely the number of seats that Sinn Féin is likely to win based on their average 17% share of support since last July.

Fianna Fáil support holds up well across all age groups and socio-economic groupings, although it clearly remains under pressure from both Sinn Féin and Independents and smaller parties in the Dublin area.



Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

If a Fianna Fáil/Sinn Féin administration cannot or will not be formed, then a rainbow coalition would be the only alternative. Based upon its current standing at 8% in Dublin, the Labour party could feasibly claw its way back to a total of circa ten sets nationwide which, along with two or even three Green Party TDs, would leave a deficit of circa 15 Independent candidates to participate in Government.

Within that context, it is worth noting that six in ten of those who indicate in today's poll that they would vote for an Independent/Other Party candidate are currently leaning towards unaligned individual independents, as opposed to more coherent groupings such as the Independent Alliance or AAA/PBP.

Things are still far from clear as to how a stable Government might be formed in the event of a 2017 election, and Fianna Fáil in particular will no doubt bear this in mind as they monitor the polls over the next two to three months.



Population Profile Perceptions

With a view to understanding how accurate or inaccurate a view the average Irish citizen has of the ethnic profile of Ireland in the 21st century, respondents were asked approximately what percentage of the Irish population they felt was originally born outside Ireland. A second question was posed as to how many refugees or asylum seekers they believe Ireland has admitted to the country over the last couple of years.

The most recent Central Statistics Office (CSO) estimates indicate that 17% of persons usually resident in Ireland in Census 2011 were born outside of Ireland. The average Irish voter actually has a very accurate understanding of this proportion.

Thus, while just over a quarter (27%) admit they do not know what the proportion of non-national residents might be, of those who do, the average estimated proportion is 19%. Just under a quarter of all Irish adults believe that 25% or more of the Irish population was originally born outside Ireland – a figure which rises to over a third of all those aged 18-34 years. There is no indication from the survey results as to whether people feel this is a good or bad thing, and it has been our experience researching social topics over the last number of years that at least as many people celebrate the growing multi-culturalism of Irish society as express concerns in relation to it.



Population Profile Perceptions

Respondents were also asked to estimate how many refugees or asylum seekers they believed Ireland has admitted to the country over the last two years or so.

The precise answer to this question is difficult to ascertain, but it is possible to make reasonable assumptions based on available Department of Justice and Equality figures which suggest that there were in the region of 6,000 refugee relocations and asylum seeker applications to Ireland between 2015 and 2016.

Based upon this estimate, today's poll would suggest that the average Irish citizen tends to under-estimate the numbers of refugees and asylum seekers who have been admitted to the country in recent years (i.e. estimated circa 3,250) – a volume which is actually quite low compared to many other European countries.
