Technical Appendix

Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 931 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.



Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 5th – 17th July, 2018.



Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.

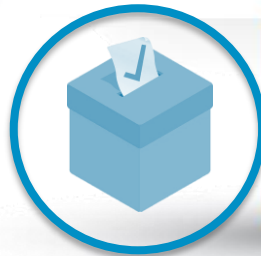
Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.

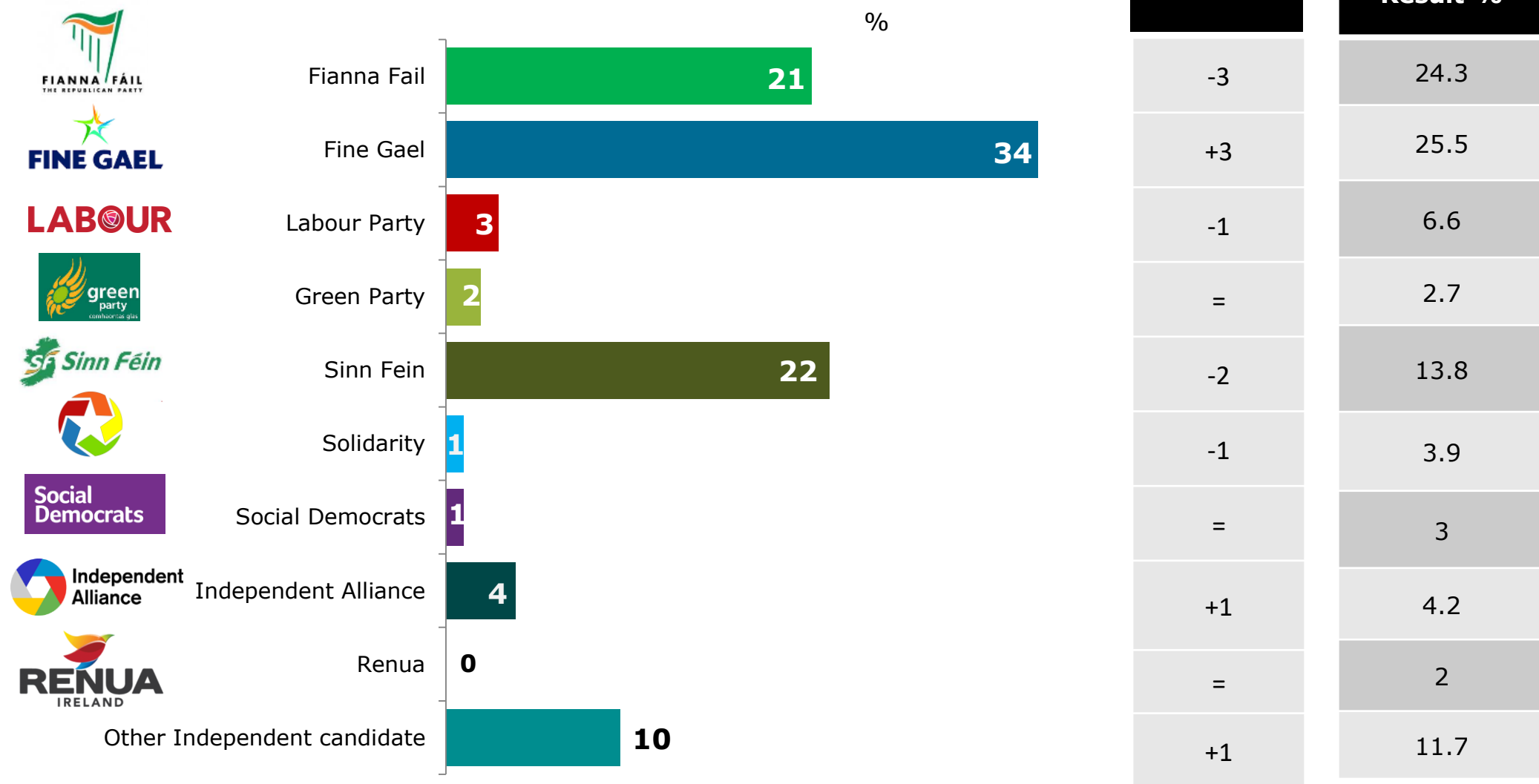

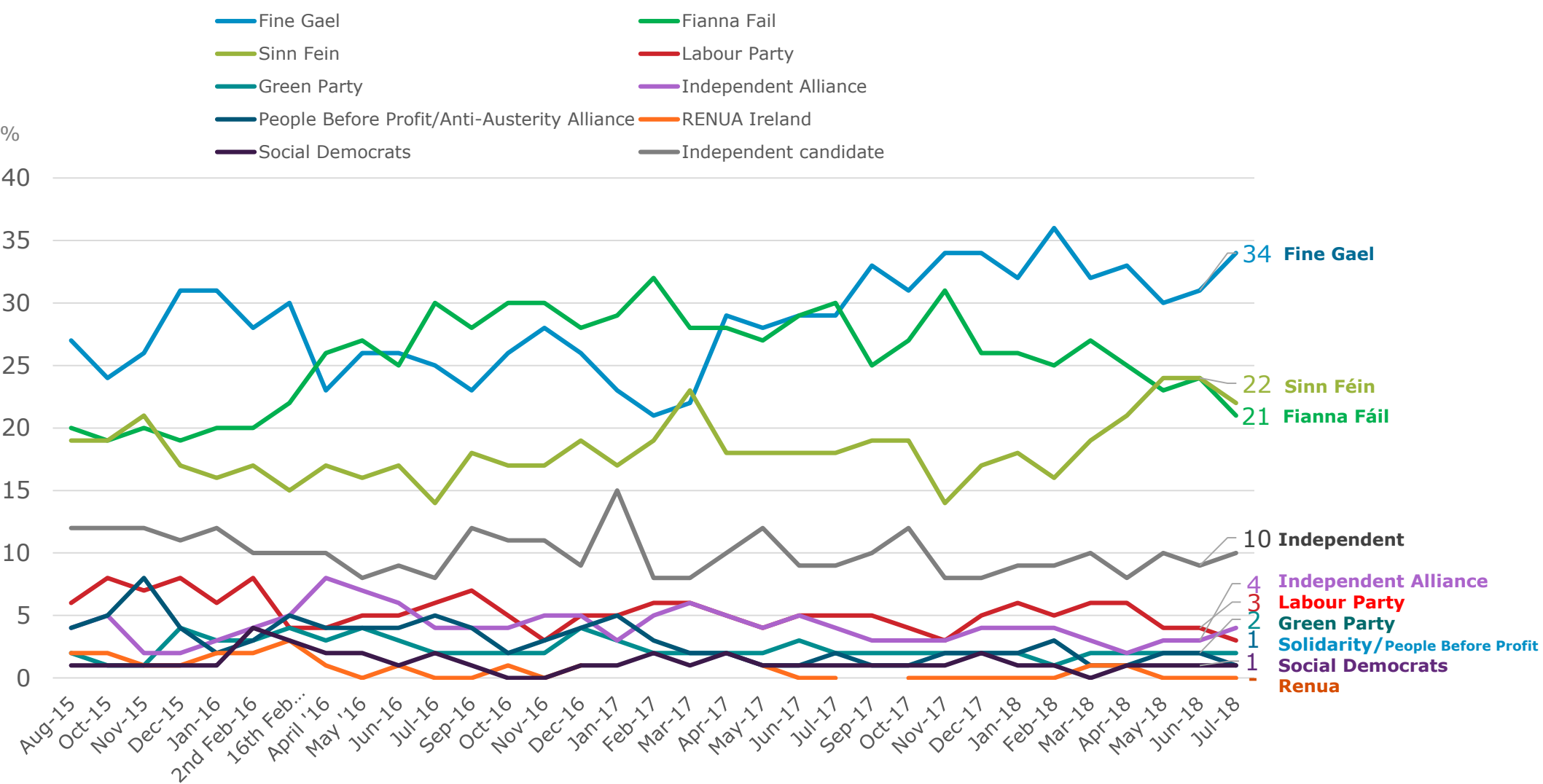

Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown (excluding undecided/adjusted)

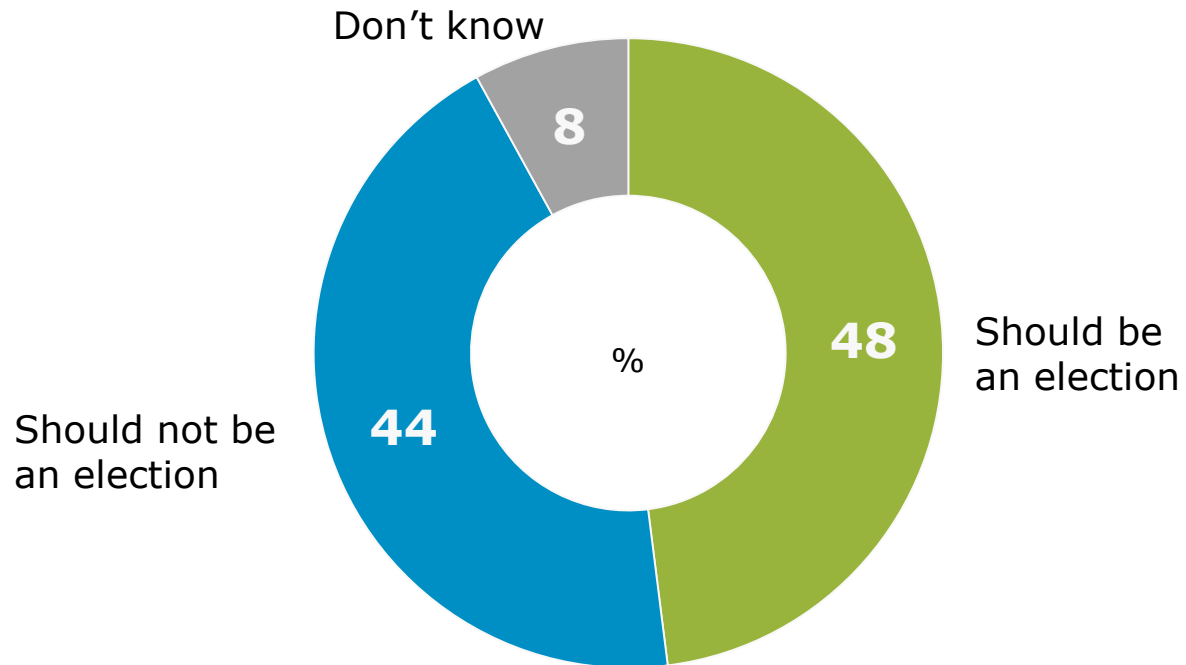


Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided – Adjusted)

Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted between Thursday, 5th and Tuesday, 17th July, 2018.

Domestically, the political landscape has been reasonably quiet since last month's poll. The seemingly intractable housing crisis continues to play out as a backdrop to practically all political discourse, with even the Taoiseach recently admitting that it poses a significant threat to the country's economic wellbeing in the short to medium term.

There is also no doubt that citizens' confidence in the economy remains fragile as Britain's Brexit negotiations with the EU lurch from one disaster to another.

This uncertainty is likely to encourage at least some people to tighten the purse-strings over the coming months until there is greater clarity on the extent to which the average household may suffer if a hard Brexit does transpire.

To compound matters, those following the global antics of Donald Trump will undoubtedly have begun to question his wisdom in launching a global trade war, the economic effects of which will presumably take months if not years to manifest themselves.

Against this background of financial uncertainty, there does not appear to be any great appetite for a General Election, unless of course Fine Gael can devise a seemingly 'blameless' means of precipitating one this side of Christmas!

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Satisfaction with the manner in which the Government is running the country has increased by two percentage points since last month to 48% today. This increase has been most pronounced amongst female voters, white collar and professional working individuals and, especially, those aged 18 to 34 years where Government satisfaction has increased by a significant 12 percentage points to 54%.

The personal satisfaction ratings of both Micheál Martin and Brendan Howlin remain unchanged month-on-month, at 49% and 43% respectively.

Leo Varadkar as Taoiseach and Mary Lou McDonald as leader of Sinn Féin remain the most popular political leaders in the country with 56% of all voters happy with Varadkar, and 53% with McDonald. Varadkar's popularity has increased somewhat amongst younger female voters, and in rural areas.

Meanwhile, McDonald has seen an uplift in popularity amongst ABC1 females aged 35 years+, and indeed in the Dublin area where her satisfaction rating has increased 8 percentage points to 55%.

Today's poll sees support for Fine Gael increased by 3 percentage points since last month to 34%. Conversely, support for Fianna Fáil has dropped by a similar margin – from 24% in June to 21% in July.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Today's is in fact Fianna Fáil's poorest performance in the opinion poll series since the end of 2015. Fine Gael's average support level over the eleven polls taken since Leo Varadkar was elected its leader stands at 33% - very much in line with this month's showing for the party.

This does confirm that support for Fine Gael under its new leader has been consistent and solid for the best part of a year now, and the party would most likely increase its number of seats in the Dáil by around a third if a general election was to occur this side of Christmas.

Having said that, the electorate has proven time and time again over the years that it does not appreciate the cynical triggering of general elections by parties whose sole motivation is perceived to be self-serving.

When the party support figures are reviewed in more granular detail, it emerges that support for both Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael has increased marginally in Dublin, with Sinn Féin support dropping by 5 percentage points in the capital. As it stands almost four in ten of all Dublin voters indicate they would give their first preference to a Fine Gael candidate in a general election, followed by 22% who would opt for Sinn Féin, 17% for Fianna Fáil and 17% for an independent or smaller party candidate.

Support for the Labour Party continues to languish, and at 3% this month is at its lowest level since last November.

If the results of today's poll were replicated in a General Election scenario, the result would most definitely be a Fine Gael led coalition – most likely including the Labour Party, Green Party and a handful of independent TDs.

It is hard to see how either Fianna Fáil or Sinn Féin could credibly slot into such an arrangement, unless of course they were to band together in a grand 'Republican' alliance.

Presidential Election Preference

As fieldwork began for this months poll, President Michael D. Higgins had still not formally announced his intention to seek a second term in office. This changed of course as fieldwork progressed, and indeed Sinn Féin's decision to nominate a presidential election was announced towards the end of survey interviewing.

Common wisdom would have it that, when asked directly, voters will generally indicate a preference for an election rather than a coronation in circumstances such as this, even if the general consensus is that the result of such an election is a foregone conclusion.

In this instance, opinion is almost evenly divided as to whether there should be a presidential election under the current circumstances or not. Thus, 48% of the electorate believes that there should be a presidential election, 44% believe that Michael D. Higgins should be returned as President for a second term without an election, with 8% undecided on the matter.

Perhaps not surprisingly, given Micheál Martin's decision not to run a party candidate, a majority (55%) of Fianna Fáil supporters are opposed to holding a Presidential election. Fine Gael supporters are split right down the middle on the issue, with a majority of supporters of all other parties strongly in favour of an election.
