Technical Appendix

Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 931 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.



Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 31st May – 12th June, 2018



Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.

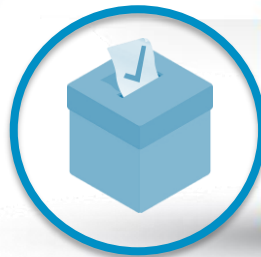
Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.

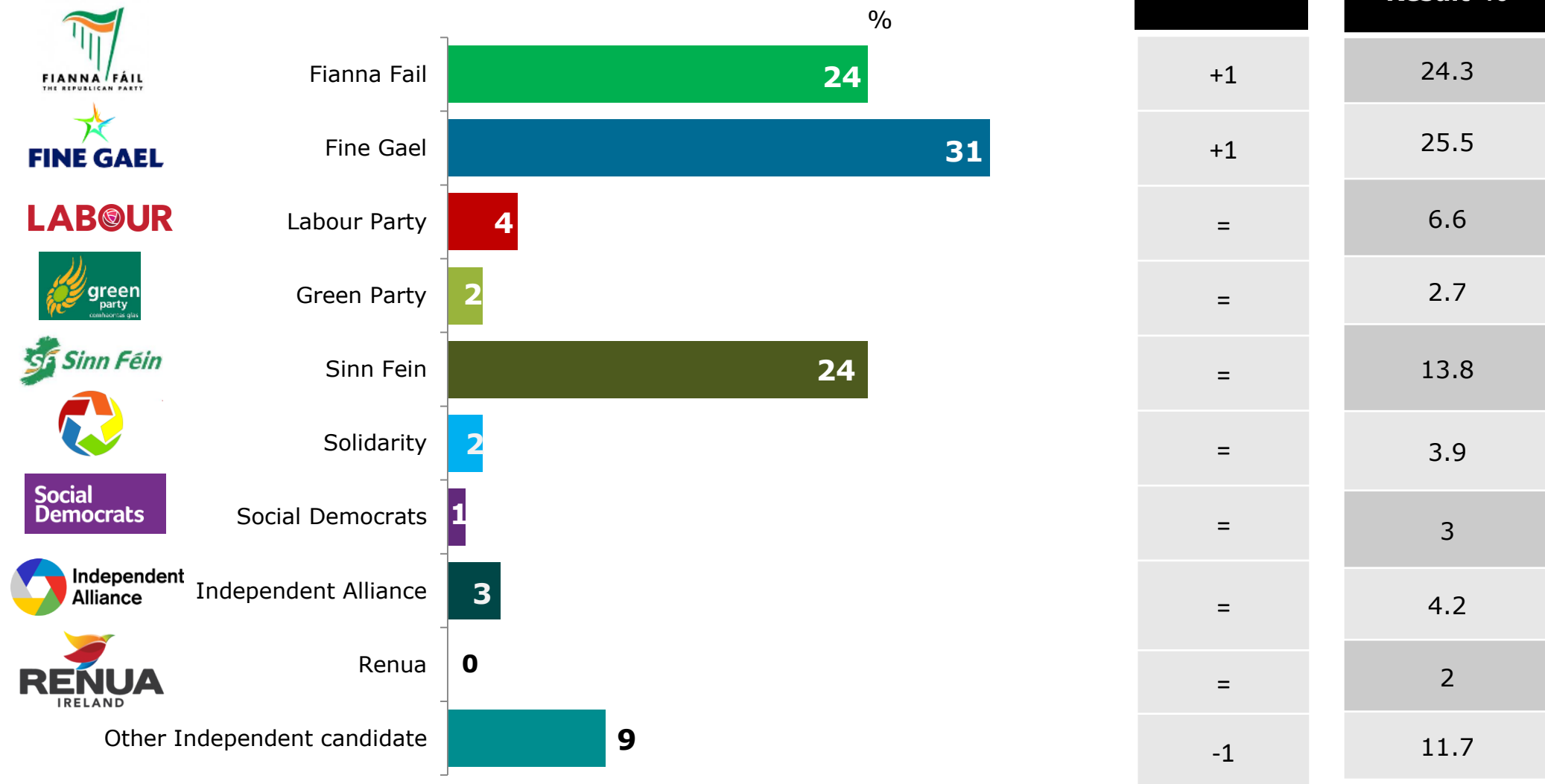

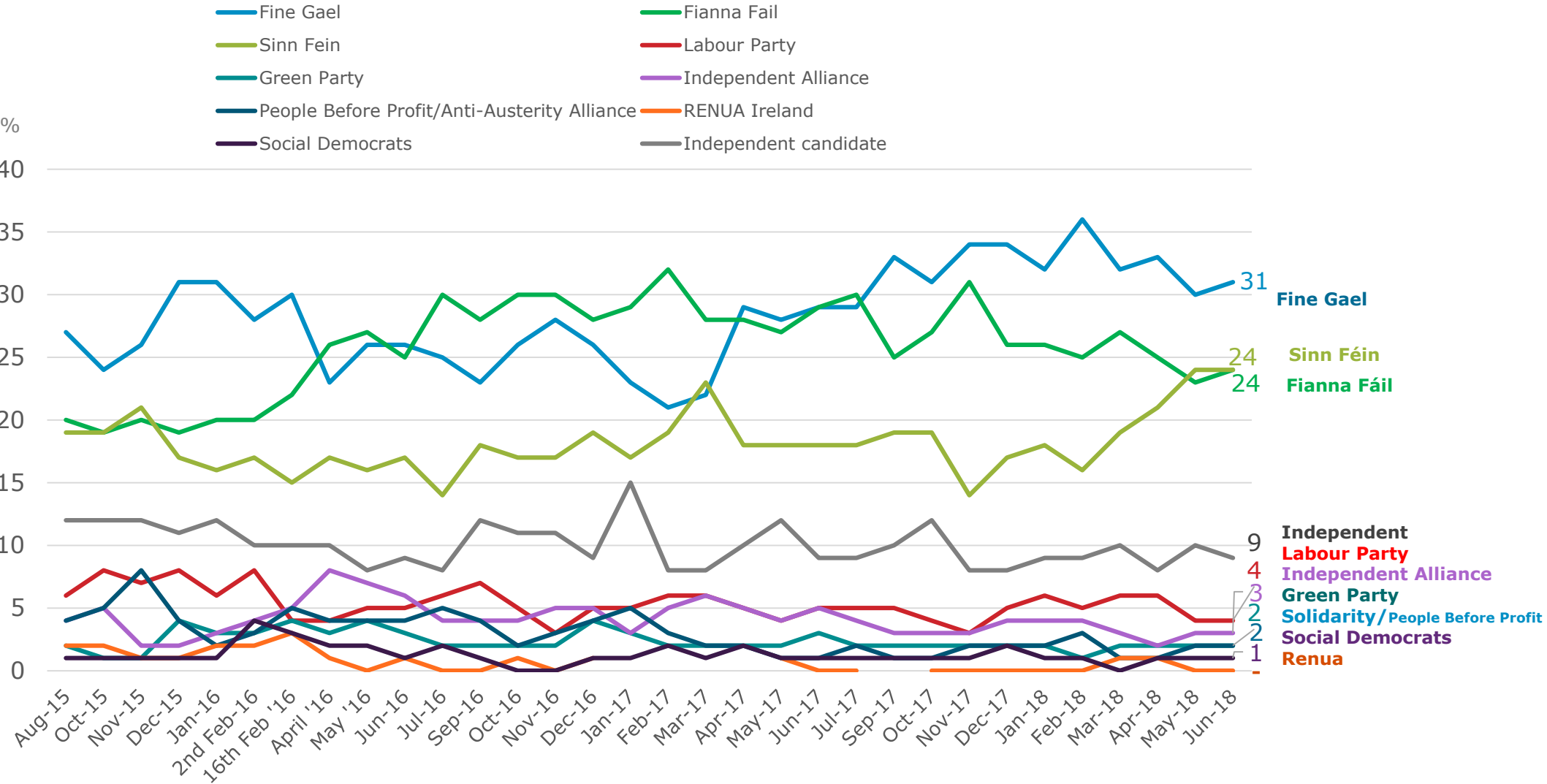

Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown (excluding undecided/adjusted)

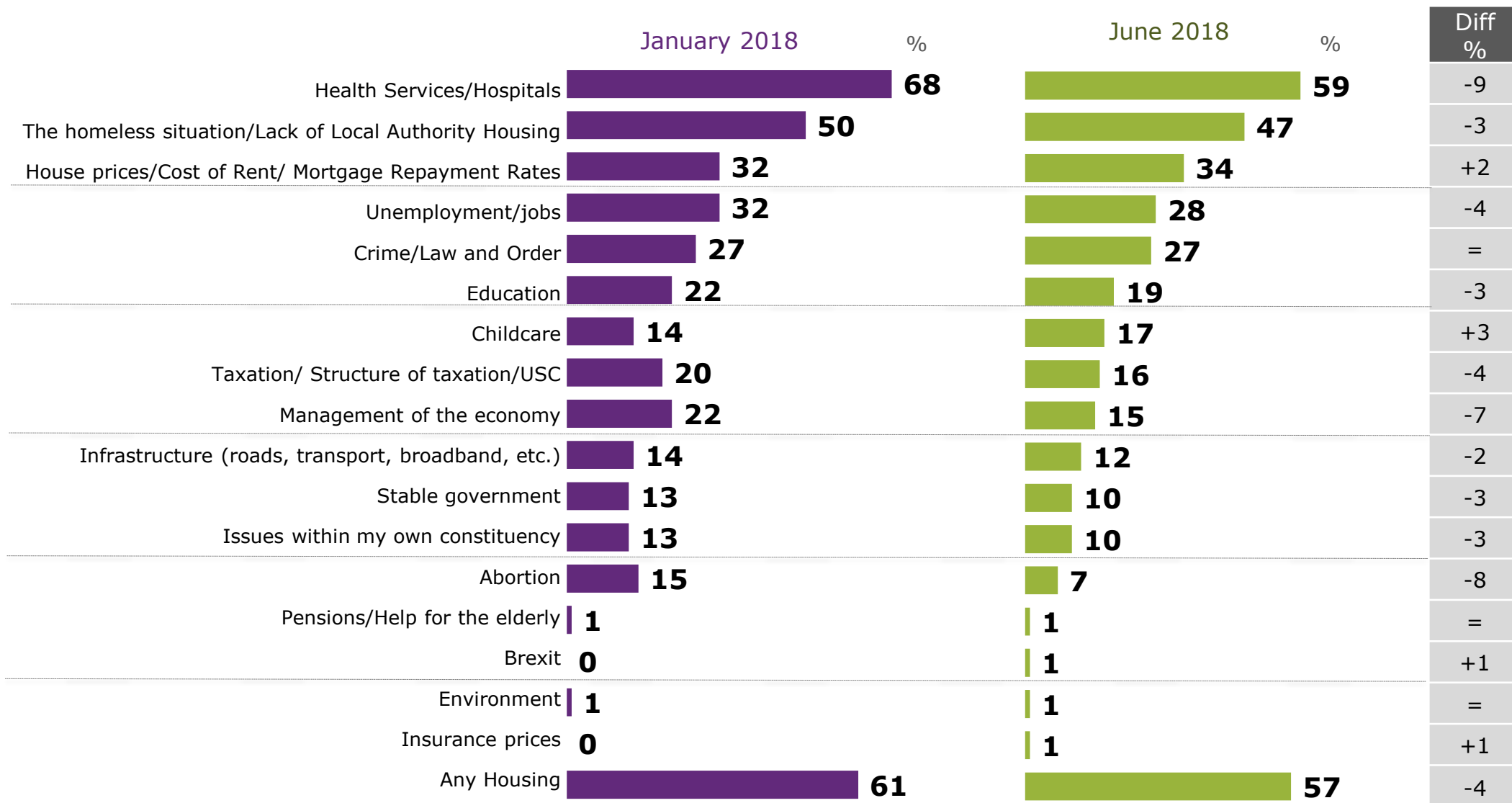


Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided – Adjusted)

Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted between Thursday, 31st May and Tuesday, 12th June, 2018.

The last Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes poll, conducted over the first two weeks of May, registered a 2:1 majority in favour of repealing the Eighth Amendment.

By 10pm on the evening of Friday, 25th May, the Behaviour & Attitudes/RTÉ Exit Poll confirmed that the public had indeed voted to repeal the Eighth Amendment by a margin of 2:1, the only remaining question being what had prompted such a landslide yes vote.

Apart from the historic nature of the Referendum in and of itself, much political discourse in the weeks since it was passed has focused on which political party – Fine Gael, Fianna Fáil or Sinn Féin, would benefit most by association with the Referendum campaign and subsequent result, if any.

Meanwhile, consumer confidence in the economy is likely to have been spooked by a range of developments over the last number of weeks.

Firstly, Brexit preparations continue to lurch from crisis to crisis and, compounded by fears over Italy's level of commitment to the EU, have raised serious concerns over the Eurozone economy. Concerns over the broader global economy will not have been helped by the instigation of a trade war by the US, with the situation only exacerbated by the last minute sabotaging of the G7 summit by Donald Trump.

Background

Closer to home, the OECD issued a warning about the potential over-heating of the Irish economy.

Taking all of the above into account, the average voter could be forgiven for any creeping sense of anxiety over their future financial wellbeing, and how exactly the Irish Government might counteract the effects of another global economic downturn.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Hot on the heels of the Referendum on the Eighth Amendment, satisfaction with the Government has increased significantly since last month's poll, with 46% of all voters now happy with the manner in which the Government is running the country, 44% unhappy, and the remainder expressing no opinion.

This improvement in Government satisfaction is most pronounced amongst males (with satisfaction increasing seven percentage points), those aged 35 to 54 years (up nine points) and white collar and professional working ABC1s (also up nine points).

Interestingly, the boost in Government satisfaction has been greatest amongst supporters of Sinn Féin, the Labour Party, Independents and smaller parties, indicating that even supporters of non Government aligned parties have been impressed with the administration's performance in recent weeks.

At a party leader level, Leo Varadkar remains the most popular politician in the country, with 55% of all voters satisfied with his performance as Taoiseach. While somewhat below Varadkar's peak rating of 59% last March, the Fine Gael leader's popularity has remained consistently high since the 49% rating first registered for him last September.

There are no significant month-on-month differences in satisfaction levels with Micheál Martin, Brendan Howlin or Mary Lou McDonald.

As such, McDonald remains the second most popular leader in the country, and at 52% satisfaction, is second only to Leo Varadkar in this regard. Micheál Martin continues to perform very well at a personal level, and his personal satisfaction rating of 49% in today's poll is underpinned by an increase in his standing amongst Sinn Féin, Independent and smaller party supporters, arguably in recognition of Martin's stance on the abortion Referendum which was at odds with so many of his party colleagues.

In terms of overall party support, there are practically no differences between last month's poll and today's, albeit with Fianna Fáil and Sinn Féin now neck and neck at 24% support each. Fine Gael is still in pole position at 31% support, with Independents and smaller parties coming in at 17%. Support for Labour remains at 4% - which has more or less been its average support level over the last 12 months.

All of these party support figures are of course calculated following the exclusion of those respondents who indicate they are undecided as to how they would vote if there was a General Election tomorrow.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

It is worth noting here that between 27% and 29% of the electorate has indicated over the last three months that it does not know how it would vote in the event of a General Election.

This is roughly the same proportion of undecided voters as was identified immediately prior to the 2016 General Election, and it does indicate that a significant tranche of the electorate remains to be convinced who to vote for at the next election, with the composition of the next Government most likely within the gift of these undecideds.

Looking forward to that next election, it is clear that Dublin will represent a key battleground for all of the parties. Currently, Fine Gael commands 34% of first preference votes in the capital, followed by Sinn Féin on 27%, Independents/Others on 18%, and Fianna Fáil on 15%.

This 'balance of power' within the Dublin area has remained quite consistent over the last number of polls. Fianna Fáil in particular will therefore need to devise and execute an aggressive strategy for the Dublin region in the very short term, lest it is caught in a pincer movement between Fine Gael and Sinn Féin for elements of its more traditional pro-business and Republican constituencies.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

While Sinn Féin will undoubtedly be more than pleased with its recent run of poll ratings, a word of caution is in order regarding its current 24% support level.

Closer analysis reveals that 40% of these potential Sinn Féin voters are aged 18 to 34 years. This compares to 28% of the total electorate who fall into this younger category. The party is clearly over-reliant on that very demographic grouping which is in reality least likely to turn out and vote in General Elections, and the party will have its work cut out to convert its vote come Election day.

Key Voter Concerns

In January of this year, a 'key issues or concerns' question was introduced to the B&A/Sunday Times series, the purpose of which was to establish an on-going measure of the topics which are most likely to influence how people vote at the next election.

This same question was repeated in this month's survey and, to all intents and purposes, the pattern of response remains the same.

For example, the top five issues of concern to Irish voters today remain Health, Homelessness/Availability of Housing, House and Rental Costs, Unemployment/Jobs, and Crime/Law and Order.

Some differences in the prioritisation of concerns is however evident since last June. For example, Abortion has dropped from 9th to 13th in the list of key issues most likely to influence how people vote in the next election; presumably as a significant proportion of the electorate now feel that the issue has been largely resolved through the Referendum.

Cross-analysis of this question by party support provides useful insights into the issues of most importance to individual parties or political groupings.

For example, it is clear from the data that Fine Gael voters are particularly motivated by issues to do with house and rental prices, taxation, infrastructure, and general management of the economy, compared to the average voter.

Key Voter Concerns

In addition to concerns over management of the economy, Fianna Fáil voters over-index compared to all others in their concerns around Crime and Law & Order.

The average Sinn Féin voter is that bit more concerned than supporters of other parties about the Homeless situation and/or lack of local Authority Housing, while Independent candidate and smaller party supporters are deeply concerned about a whole raft of issues from Health to Unemployment, Education and Childcare.
