# **Technical Appendix**

## **Technical Appendix**

- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 934 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.
- Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period Tuesday, 28<sup>th</sup> Feb Wednesday, 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2017.
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socioeconomic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



## **Technical Appendix**

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

## **Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note**

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish
  their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They
  also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how
  people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one
  we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.




## Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided - Adjusted)

# Commentary

### **Background**

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February to Wednesday, 8<sup>th</sup> March. The period leading up to, and during, fieldwork was certainly an eventful one, with numerous factors at play in influencing voter opinions.

Not least of these factors has been the series of on-going revelations and scandals regarding children's welfare.

The first of these relates of course to the on-going scandal concerning the treatment of a number of Garda whistleblowers including Maurice McCabe. The role of Tusla in particular in propagating false allegations of child abuse against McCabe was truly shocking. The public was also genuinely perplexed by An Taoiseach Enda Kenny's reaction to the affair, amidst doubts over his version of events surrounding conversations he had with children's Minister Katherine Zappone about the matter.

In addition to the latter subject, the period of survey fieldwork was dominated by coverage of the discovery of the mass graves of infants and children following excavations by the Commission of Investigation into Mother and Baby Homes.

To add to this sense of despair at the State's protection of its children's rights was the case of 'Grace' and the HSE's role in failing to remove her from an abusive foster home environment.



### **Background**

Another major story which was unfolding in the lead up to today's poll was the outcome of the Northern Assembly Elections. Specifically, there was much commentary and analysis around the remarkable performance of Sinn Féin, and indeed the SDLP, in wrestling the balance of power in the North from Unionism for the first time since partition.

It will be interesting to see if the images of a newly energised Sinn Féin will have a sustainable impact on voters south of the border.

Finally, survey respondents can hardly have failed to note Enda Kenny's (slightly vague) indication of a timeline for his departure as Taoiseach and leader of Fine Gael.

With a Fine Gael leadership contest likely to begin in earnest following St. Patrick's weekend, the political landscape is set to become a lot more interesting over the next couple of months than it has been over the last.



#### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

Last month's Behaviour & Attitudes/Sunday Times poll was quite a worrying one for Fine Gael. The party's support had slid for the third month in a row, equalling the party's all-time low in the polling series, which had previously been registered in April 2014.

Conversely, support for Fianna Fáil had hit an historical high, with 32% of the electorate indicating they would vote for it in the event of a general election.

Today's poll provides little comfort for Fine Gael, insofar as party support currently sits at 22% - essentially identical to last month's showing. Support for the party still peaks amongst the 55 years+ age category, and its positioning improves marginally in the Dublin area where support has increased three percentage points compared to last month.

Perhaps not surprisingly given his recently announced intention to vacate the position as Fine Gael leader, satisfaction with Enda Kenny as Taoiseach drops three percentage points to 27% today. Crucially, the Taoiseach's personal satisfaction rating now stands at 70% of core Fine Gael voters, a figure which stood at 78% of the party faithful in our last poll.

In line with these latter findings, satisfaction with the Government has dropped to just 26% of all voters. This represents a drop of three percentage points since February, and we are now in a position whereby two-thirds of the electorate is unhappy with the manner in which the country is being run – a figure which rises to 70% of females and indeed 70% of all potential voters aged 35 years and older.



#### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

While the poll findings will clearly make for some uncomfortable reading amongst Fine Gael strategists, Fianna Fáil are likely to be somewhat disappointed by their four percentage point dip since our last poll.

Having said that, at 28% support in today's survey, the party is just two points lower than its average level of support in the previous five polls, and the party is still the most popular in the country, with a six point lead over Fine Gael.

Just under half of the electorate (49%) is satisfied with Micheál Martin's performance as leader of Fianna Fáil – allowing him retain the mantle of the most popular party leader in the country.

The most significant finding in today's poll is however the large increase in support for Sinn Féin, whose 23% support level represents a four percentage point increase since last month.

Clearly, the near-blanket coverage of that party's success in the Northern Assembly elections has had a positive spill-over effect for the party south of the border. This surge in support for Sinn Féin positions the party as the most popular in the Dublin area (albeit at 25%, only marginally), and in effect, neck and neck with both Fianna Fáil (23%) and Fine Gael (23%) in the capital.

Finally, support for the smaller parties and Independents registers at 20% today. This still represents a significant proportion of the electorate who indicate they may shun the mainstream parties in the event of an election, and it is interesting to note that 56% of voters who fall into this category are from a white collar and professional working background.



#### **Fine Gael Leadership Preference**

The final question in this month's poll asked respondents whether they would prefer Richard Bruton, Simon Coveney, Frances Fitzgerald, Simon Harris or Leo Varadkar as leader of Fine Gael.

Fieldwork had almost been completed by the time Simon Harris ruled himself out of the race, although this is unlikely to have had a material effect on the overall pattern of response to the question, given the relatively low numbers who opted for him.

At a national level, three in ten of all Irish voters would like to see Leo Varadkar elected as the new Fine Gael leader. This preference is most acute in Dublin (35%) and amongst white collar/professional ABC1 individuals (35%).

The next most popular candidate for party leader amongst the general public is Simon Coveney, who attracts 18% support – a figure which rises to 24% of rural dwellers.

While the views of the general public are clearly of interest in the Fine Gael leadership race, the real decision will be made by Fine Gael officials and members around the country.

Indeed, when we view responses to the leadership question amongst the core Fine Gael Support base, we see that opinion is evenly split between Simon Coveney at 41%, and Leo Varadkar at 38%.

The question remains as to how the party membership feels about the matter.
