



# **Technical Appendix**

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- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 919 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 26th October 7th November, 2017.
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socioeconomic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



#### **Technical Appendix**

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

#### **Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note**

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.



## Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided - Adjusted)






### **Average No. of hours Sleep**






Incidence of taking medication or consulting a doctor about

# Commentary

#### **Background**

Last month's Behaviour & Attitudes/Sunday Times poll witnessed a narrowing of the gap in support between Fine Gael and Fianna Fáil, with the former dropping two points, the latter increasing two points and the net effect being Fine Gael maintaining its position as the most popular party in the country, by a margin of four percentage points over Fianna Fáil.

These findings were part of a broader trend in the polling series which has seen the two main parties grow in support since the last General Election, to the point whereby they have collectively been garnering almost 60% of the popular vote.

The main losers over the same period have been independent candidates and smaller parties, including the Labour Party. Fieldwork for November's poll ran over the 12 day period up to Tuesday, 7<sup>th</sup> November last.

As fieldwork progressed, coverage of the Paradise Papers and tracker mortgage scandals was at its peak, a number of reports confirming the accelerating rise in property rental prices was published and the series of one day rail stoppages was in full swing.

Meanwhile, despite protracted and quite messy Brexit negotiations between the EU and the UK, the Irish economy continued to perform well, with one report confirming that Irish household debt is now at its lowest level since before the Celtic Tiger.



#### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

Just two years ago, three months before the last General Election, Government satisfaction was languishing at just 28%. This figure did recover to the mid 30's in the immediate run up to the Election, and plodded along at more or less the same level up until the summer of this year.

Against this quite consistent backdrop, today's Government satisfaction rating of 44% is notable – representing an increase of five percentage points since last month alone.

This uplift in Government approval has been most pronounced amongst those aged 18-54 years, male voters, and white collar and professional working individuals.

When Leo Varadkar was elected Taoiseach this year, his inaugural personal satisfaction rating registered at 43% - a full six percentage points higher than his predecessor Enda Kenny had achieved immediately prior to his resignation.

Common wisdom would have it that following an initial post-coronation bounce, a new party leader's satisfaction rating will settle down to a level a little below that of his or hers first opinion poll rating.

The opposite has been the case with regard to Leo Varadkar. In fact, his November 2017 personal satisfaction rating of 52% is the highest registered for any Fine Gael leader in this polling series, and positions the Taoiseach as the most popular political leader in the country – albeit just ahead of Micheál Martin.

Compared to last month's poll, it is clear that Varadkar's most recent increase in popularity has been highest in rural areas – especially within the Leinster Rural region.

From a party political perspective, the momentum of the last few months towards Fine Gael and Fianna Fáil continues, with two-thirds of the electorate now indicating they would vote for either one of those parties if there was a General Election tomorrow.

While initially the main losers in this surge towards the mainsteam had been Independents and smaller parties, today's evidence suggests that the rot has now spread to Sinn Féin, whose support drops a very significant five percentage points to just 14% today.

Meanwhile, the Labour Party's 3% showing matches its previous all time low measured exactly 12 months ago.

Fine Gael's increase in support of three percentage points since last month is evenly spread across all gender and age groups, but is particularly marked in Dublin and other urban areas, as well as amongst ABC1 'middle class' voters.

Indeed, at 41% support in the Dublin area, Fine Gael would win twice as many seats as Fianna Fáil in the capital if these figures were to be repeated come election day.

Conversely, Fianna Fáil's four percentage point increase in support to 31% since last month has been generated almost exclusively from rural areas around the country, although the party's fortunes have also improved across all age groups and socio-economic groupings.

Certainly, the results of today's poll will give cold comfort to any Fianna Fáil strategists considering cutting and running to the country any time soon, with the most likely post-election scenario if they were to do so being that of a rainbow coalition led by Taoiseach Varadkar.



#### **Irish Sleep Patterns**

Whether based on empirical scientific evidence or not, the common consensus seems to be that we need in or around eight hours sleep in an average night if we are to function effectively the next day.

With a view to gauging how the Irish populace is faring on this front, respondents were asked approximately how many hours sleep they manage to get in an average night, whether they feel this is enough, and indeed whether they have ever consulted a doctor, or take medication for sleep-related issues.

The average Irish voter receives 7 hours and 19 minutes sleep a night, a figure which rises to 7 hours and 26 minutes amongst those aged 18-34 years (a group which presumably includes its fair share of third level students), and drops to just 7 hours and 4 minutes amongst 35-54 year olds (i.e. those most likely to be out and about in the workforce).

In total, over half a million Irish voters believe they are not getting enough sleep to allow them function effectively the next day; equating to just under one in six of all Irish adults.

Females, 35-54 year olds, ABC1 'middle class' workers and urban dwellers claim to be the most sleep deprived of all.



From a political perspective, Fine Gael voters seem to be getting the best night's sleep of all, with just one in ten of them complaining they do not get enough shut-eye.

One in ten of our respondents have ever consulted a doctor about sleeping issues – more likely to be older (55 years+) individuals, and blue collar working urban dwellers.

Finally, in or around 200,000 adults claim to be taking medication to help them sleep, almost two-thirds of them aged over 55 years.
