Technical Appendix

- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 938 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 25th May 6th June, 2017.
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socioeconomic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



Technical Appendix

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).



Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish
 their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They
 also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how
 people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one
 we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.



Party Support Levels (Excluding Undecided - Adjusted)




- Adjusted figures based on:
 - All who state they would definitely vote
 - Weighting of those respondents who give a definite answer as to who they would vote for in a general election and who they voted for in the last election, a quarter of the way between stated voting intention and the result of the last election.
 - Making no adjustment to stated voting intention of those who do not indicate how they voted in last election.


Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided - Adjusted)






Would you consider yourself to be overweight, underweight, or about the right weight for someone of your height?






Efforts to lose weight

Commentary

Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Thursday 25th May – Tuesday, 6th June, 2017.

There was really only one domestic political news story over this period, and that was the campaign for the leadership of the Fine Gael party.

Most of the interviews for the poll were completed in advance of the leadership election count on Friday, 2nd June, and the subsequent announcement of Leo Varadkar as victor.

Regardless of when the actual votes were cast, however, it had become apparent to most people in the country that Varadkar was most likely to prevail at the end of the day, with the great majority of the members of the parliamentary party having declared early in the race for the Minister for Social Protection.

Certainly, prospective Fine Gael voters would have had the opportunity over the course of the campaign to consider the policy differences between the two candidates, and will presumably have been influenced by such factors in their response to today's survey.



Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Over the last three consecutive Behaviour & Attitudes/Sunday Times polls, between 56% and 58% of all Irish voters have expressed dissatisfaction with the manner in which the minority Government is running the country.

In fact, the only party whose supporters have been in any way satisfied with the Government is Fine Gael itself – two-thirds of whose potential voters say they are happy with the way their party is managing affairs.

Conversely, circa six in ten of all Fianna Fáil voters are expressly unhappy with the Government – a statistic which begs the question as to how long Micheál Martin's position as the most popular political leader in the country can last if he continues to prop up an administration which is so unpopular amongst his own party faithful.

Demographically, the Government has been consistently more popular amongst males (42% Government satisfaction in today's poll) than it has amongst females (28% in today's poll).

As Enda Kenny departs the stage, he may glean some comfort from the fact that his personal satisfaction rating, at 37%, is at its highest level since April 2014, although it is difficult to deduce whether this slight boost in favourability is due to his recent performance as Taoiseach, or the fact that he has finally decided to hand the reins over to somebody else!



Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

It is quite remarkable that Micheál Martin remains the only party leader whose satisfaction ratings out-weigh his dissatisfaction level – and uniformly so across all age groups, regions, socio-economic groupings and both males and females.

Undoubtedly, Martin is one of Fianna Fáil's greatest assets, and barring any unforeseen catastrophe, will most certainly lead the Soldiers of Destiny into the next election.

If that election had been held at any time over the last couple of weeks, it would most likely have produced a hung Dáil, with both Fianna Fáil and Fine Gael capturing between 45 and 50 seats apiece, with Sinn Féin and Independents/smaller parties returning in the region of 30 TDs each, and the Labour Party trailing badly at in or around its current level of 7 seats.

With the two main parties locked on 29% support in today's poll, it is worth reviewing differences in profile between the two support bases, with a view to understanding which of the opposition blocs might represent the neatest 'fit' as coalition partners.

This voter profile analysis reveals that Fine Gael's 29% support amongst all voters skews most heavily towards males (36%), farmers (49%), the more well-heeled ABC1 social class (35%), and those resident in Dublin (32%), and Connaught/Ulster (36%).

Fianna Fáil's nationwide 29% support level over-indexes amongst females (32%), those aged 55 years + (35%), and residents of both Connaught/Ulster (36%) and Munster (31%).

It will be fascinating to observe the direction that Leo Varadkar takes his party in over the coming months – will he aim to build upon his 29% in attempting to appeal to all sections of society, or consolidate closer to the 26% the party achieved in the last election by targeting specific sections of the electorate, such as those who "get up early in the morning".

On the surface of it, the Sinn Féin voter seems to have more in common with the typical Fianna Fáil voter, insofar as both perform well amongst the C2DE blue collar working constituency – the one grouping where Fine Gael consistently under-performs.

It is more difficult to tease out the intricacies of the Independent/Other grouping, other than to point out that support for the likes of Solidarity/People Before Profit has shrunk to just 1% in today's poll, while the likes of the more centrist Independent Alliance has held solid at 5% support nationwide – rising to 8% in Dublin.

We are of course some way removed from a general election, but based on today's poll, the most logical or even likely outcome would be that of a Fianna Fáil/Sinn Féin coalition – perhaps not as outlandish a proposition as it seemed just a year ago.



Weight of the Nation

An April 2016 a Lancet study revealed that Ireland has the highest average Body Mass Index (BMI) in the EU – 27.4 to be precise, meaning that the average Irish adult is slightly overweight.

Further analysis of that study identified that 26% of Irish adults were categorised as obese – and this percentage does not include the presumably significant proportion who also qualify as overweight, albeit not yet clinically obese.

It is an established phenomenon in social research that people believe they are healthier than they actually are, whether that be expressed in terms of weight, alcohol consumption, or other such medical metrics.

The results of today's poll certainly validate that assumption. Thus, just 25% of all Irish adults believe they are overweight, 4% feel they are under-weight, while the great majority (68%) believe that their weight is about right for their height.

Females, older individuals, and people living in rural areas, are marginally more likely to declare themselves overweight compared to the average.

Two-thirds of those who believe they are overweight, claim they have made a conscious effort to slim down within the last 12 months or so – with females, "middle aged spread" 35-54 year olds, and white collar/professional working urban residents, all more likely to have made an attempt to shed a few pounds.



Weight of the Nation

Within the sub-group of people who have attempted to lose weight, only one-third of them managed to lose weight and maintain that lower weight level. The majority either managed to lose weight but put most of it back on again (51%), or did not lose any/much weight to begin with (17%).
