



Technical Appendix

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- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 913 eligible
 Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.
- Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 3rd 15th June, 2016.
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socioeconomic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



Technical Appendix

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the
 evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period
 between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish
 their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They
 also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how
 people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next
 one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election
 results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.




Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown (excluding undecided/adjusted)


Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided - Adjusted)



Commentary

Background

It is now more than three months since the General Election, and just over one month since the Government was formed. Indeed today's is the first Sunday Times Poll whose fieldwork was conducted in its entirety after the formation of that Government.

In political terms, the fieldwork period for today's poll was relatively quiet. People's primary concerns over the course of the survey are likely to have related to such mundane matters as the prolonged sunny spell, and the beginning of the Junior and Leaving Cert Examinations.

News stories were still dominated by the on-going Dublin gangland feud, and the apparent inability of the authorities to manage that situation.

On a related matter, public confidence in An Garda Síochána continued to be challenged with regard to a range of issues, from the historical treatment of whistle blowers to the broader criticism of the force highlighted in the O'Higgins report.

The survey was also carried out in the aftermath of the UN Human Rights Committee ruling that Ireland's ban on abortion could be deemed, at least in part, to be cruel, inhuman or degrading to women. The reaction of the Government to that pronouncement was a commitment to convene a Citizens Assembly to discuss and advise on a possible Referendum on the eight amendment to the Constitution.

All in all, therefore, there were few burning 'hot topics' which might have dominated public discourse over the fieldwork period, to the extent that any one party or group of politicians might have consequently suffered or gained in today's poll.



Background

If anything, overseas news dominated the airwaves over the last couple of weeks, not least the growing possibility that UK citizens will vote for a Brexit on Tuesday, 23rd June next. Certainly economic commentators had become jittery around the potential impact of a Brexit on Ireland's economy, and the potential to plunge the country back into recession.

Meanwhile in the US, Donald Trump had emerged as a real possibility for the Presidency, and of course the public's collective psyche will have been appalled and traumatised by images of yet another act of mass terrorism at a nightclub in Orlando.

Taking all of the above into account, it can be argued that public opinion at the moment is tainted by a real sense of uncertainty at the state of today's society, both at home and abroad.

There is a general feeling amongst the electorate that there is a greater need than ever before for clear and firm leadership from our politicians, at a time when few seem to have faith in the likelihood of this Government lasting more than a year or two.

Not surprisingly, given the state of flux since the General Election, satisfaction with the performance of the Government (or lack of Government) was close to an all-time low in both April and May's opinion polls.

In both of those surveys, two-thirds of the electorate expressed dissatisfaction with how the country was being governed, with less than a quarter satisfied.

One would have expected some semblance of normality to have returned to response levels to this question since the Government was formed.

In reality, there has been no significant improvement in satisfaction with the Government since last month's poll, with just over a quarter (26%) of the electorate happy with the way in which the country is being run. 63% are dissatisfied with the Government – a figure which rises to 7 in 10 of the blue collar working C2DE section of the population. Indeed, Fine Gael supporters are the only grouping which profess any level of satisfaction with the manner in which the Government is running the country, at 62% overall.

By way of comparison, satisfaction with the manner in which the Government was running the country registered at an average of 32% across all polls conducted in the 12 months leading up to February's election.

When Joan Burton was elected leader of the Labour party in 2014, her personal satisfaction rating stood at 45% - typical of the type of 'bounce' that a new leader is granted during his/her honeymoon period. Burton's personal rating then settled in to a fairly consistent 35% in the 12 months leading up to the election, dipping to just 28% after that debacle for the party.

Brendan Howlin should therefore be reasonably happy with his very first personal satisfaction rating of 40% as leader of the Labour Party, a figure which positions him as the second most popular leader in the country after Micheál Martin. As Mr. Howlin takes the reins in his mission to rebuild his party, he will take note of the fact that he is most popular amongst females, those aged 55 years+ and Dublin residents.

In terms of party leader satisfaction the real winner from the General Election was Micheál Martin of Fianna Fáil, whose satisfaction rating in last month's poll stood at 44% of all voters.

Today, we see Mr. Martin's personal rating increase again, albeit marginally, to a near all time high of 46%. Interestingly, Micheál Martin's satisfaction ratings peak amongst the very same demographic cohorts that Brendan Howlin over-indexes on.

Conversely, the post election party leader 'losers' were Enda Kenny whose satisfaction four weeks ago stood at just 26%, and Gerry Adams as leader of Sinn Féin whose popularity had plummeted from a high of 48% in April 2014 to 30% by May of this year.

Today's survey results will bring no comfort to either of those party leaders, and Enda Kenny as Taoiseach again registers the lowest level of personal satisfaction amongst his contemporaries – remaining at a solid 26% over the last three consecutive polls. Similarly, Gerry Adam's rating as leader of Sinn Féin sits on just 31%, with more than a quarter (27%) of Sinn Féin party supporters now dissatisfied with his leadership of their party, and a further 7% of them uncertain.

A notable feature of last month's poll, apart from the fact that Fiánna Fáil and Fine Gael were neck and neck in terms of popular support, was the significant decline in support for independent candidates and smaller parties, from 27% in the last pre-Election poll and the following poll in April, to just 22% in May.

This combined bloc registers a modest, and statistically insignificant uplift of two percentage points in June. When broken out in further detail this vote is splayed across a range of solus candidates, and the likes of the Independent Alliance, AAA/PBP Alliance, Green Party, etc.

Support for the main parties remains practically static month-on-month, a reflection perhaps of the general sense of torpor which seems to have descended upon the political landscape since the inconclusive outcome of the General Election.

Fianna Fáil will nevertheless be happy enough that it remains tied with Fine Gael, and in contention for the role as most popular party in the country. Support for Fianna Fáil, while dropping an insignificant two percentage points month on month has actually increased very marginally amongst male voters, and amongst 35-54 year olds (from 21% to 28%). The party's support has, however, dropped quite significantly amongst the ABC1 white collar and professional socio-economic grouping by seven percentage points over the same period, albeit increasing by two percentage points among the C2DE 'working class' constituency.



Levels of Confidence in An Garda Síochána

The last number of years have been difficult ones for An Garda Síochána from a public confidence perspective.

From the 2008 Morris Tribunal report into claims of corruption in policing in County Donegal, up to last month's O'Higgins Commission Report concerning the Cavan/Monaghan Division, the manner in which the force has conducted its business in a fair and balanced fashion has been called into serious doubt.

In addition to those institutional Tribunal reports, there seems to have been a constant flow of allegations of misconduct by senior Gardai, including but by no means limited to the treatment of Garda whistle-blowers both before and after the resignation of Garda Commissioner Callinan.

Against this backdrop, respondents in today's poll were questioned in relation to their views of the force, across a number of attributes.

The first such question asked respondents to identify from four options on a show card (A Lot, Some, A Little and None) how much confidence they would have in the Garda Síochána to properly investigate three types of crime if they reported it. A cross-section of different types of crime, from what might be construed as less serious (e.g. car theft/damage) to significantly more serious (i.e. an assault) were included at this question for comparative purpose.



Levels of Confidence in An Garda Síochána

In response, a majority of Irish citizens indicated that they had a lot or some confidence in the Garda Síochána to properly investigate all three types of crime. There was, however, significantly greater confidence in the force to properly investigate an assault (with 66% either a lot confident or confident to some degree), compared to the likes of a house burglary (58% overall confidence) and car theft/damage (56% overall confidence).

Conversely, some will find it worrying that 40% of all citizens have only a little or no confidence in the Gardai to properly investigate the likes of a house burglary, with the corresponding figures for car theft/damage standing at 41% having little or no confidence in its proper investigation, and 31% having little or no confidence in the proper investigation of an assault.

Respondents were then asked whether they agree or disagree with two statements about the Garda Síochána. One of these statements referred to whether people believed there is a culture of secrecy and defensiveness in the Garda Síochána, while the other referred to there being a culture of openness and transparency in the Garda Síochána. The order in which these balancing statements was read out to respondents was rotated, to avoid any bias in response.



Levels of Confidence in An Garda Síochána

The results for this question are particularly unsettling, with almost two-thirds (63%) of the Irish electorate indicating that they believe there is a culture of secrecy and defensiveness in the Garda Síochána.

This view is particularly strong amongst males and those aged 35 years+, and is relatively consistent across all regions of the country.

In contrast, just over a quarter (26%) of all Irish voters believe there is a culture of openness and transparency in the Garda Síochána, with a majority (53%) disagreeing with this altogether, and a further 21% uncertain.

The results of this set of questions are clear – while a majority are satisfied with the job that regular Gardai are doing policing their communities on a day to day basis, there is deep disquiet with regard to the matter in which the organisation is being run, and with how recent scandals have been dealt with in an open and honest fashion.
