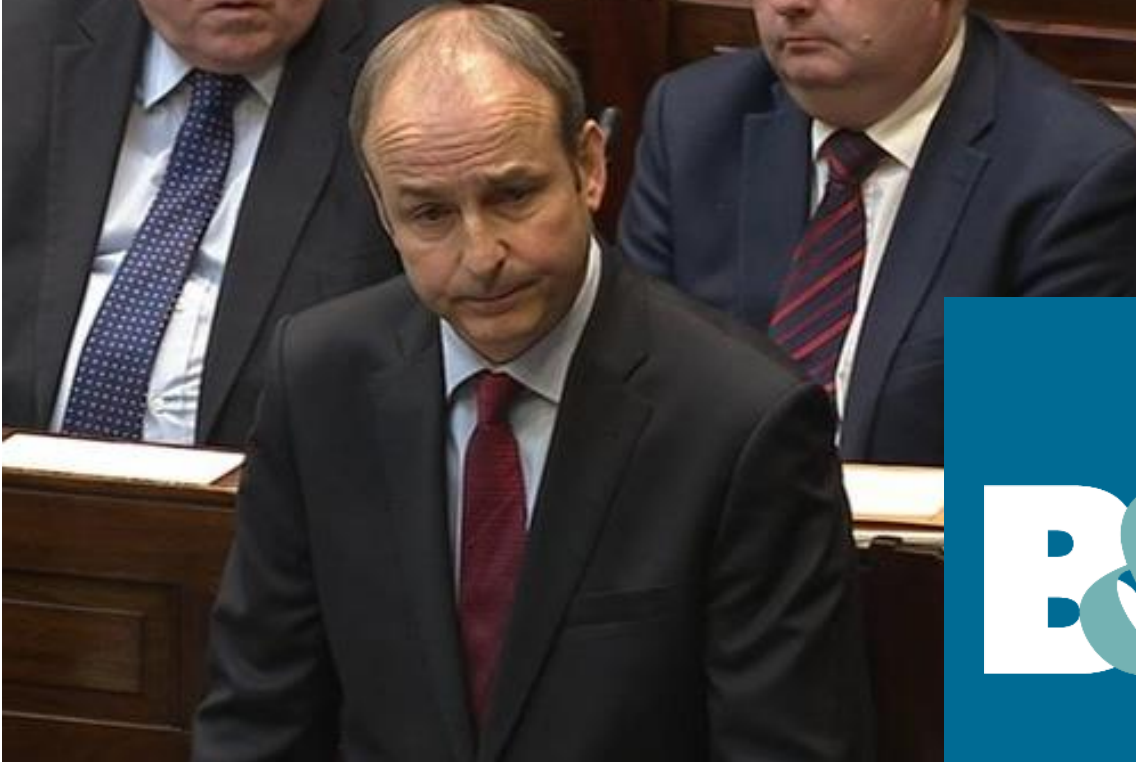

Technical Appendix

Technical Appendix

- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 920 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 4th to 16th January 2018.
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.

Technical Appendix

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.

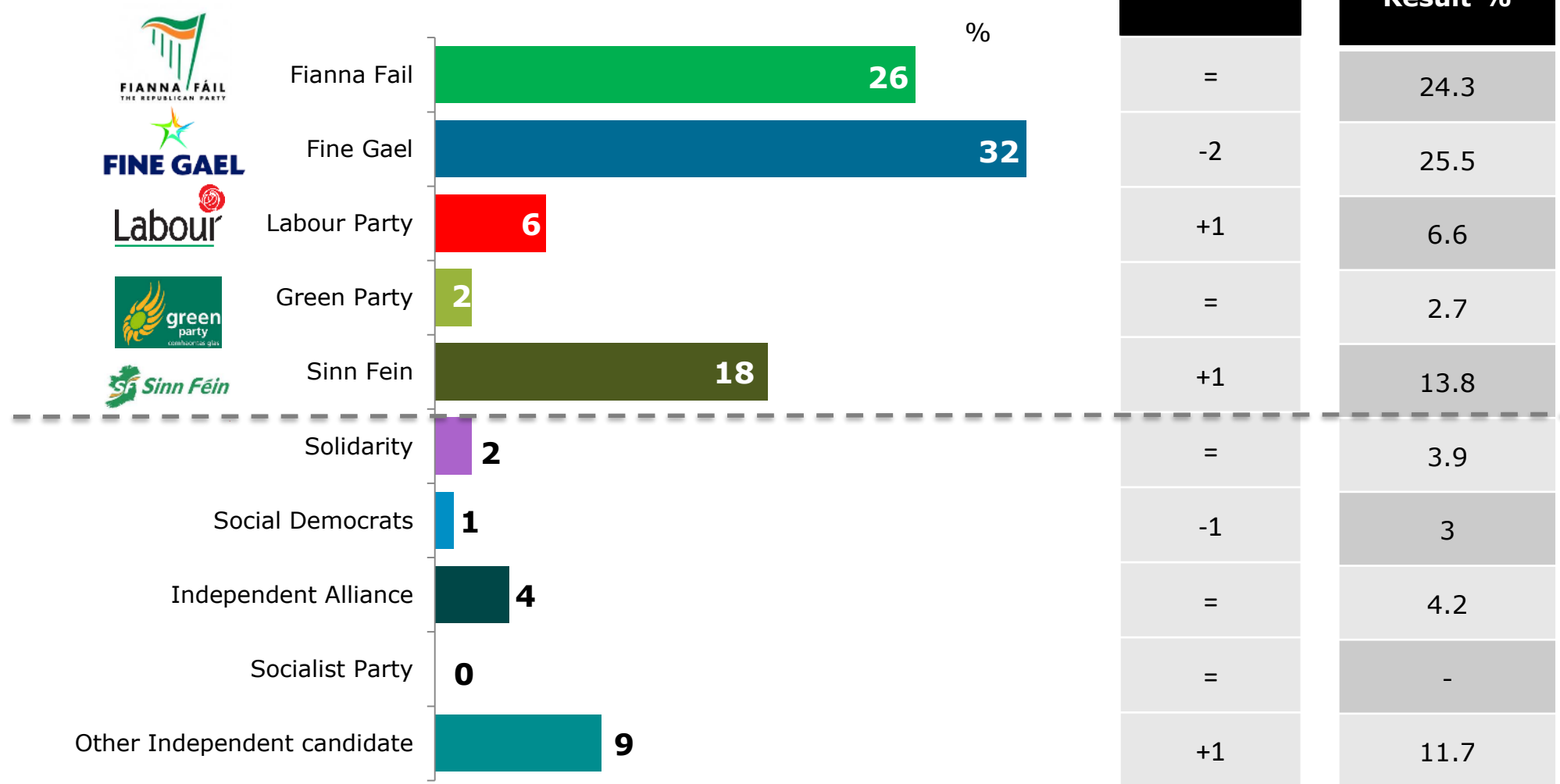

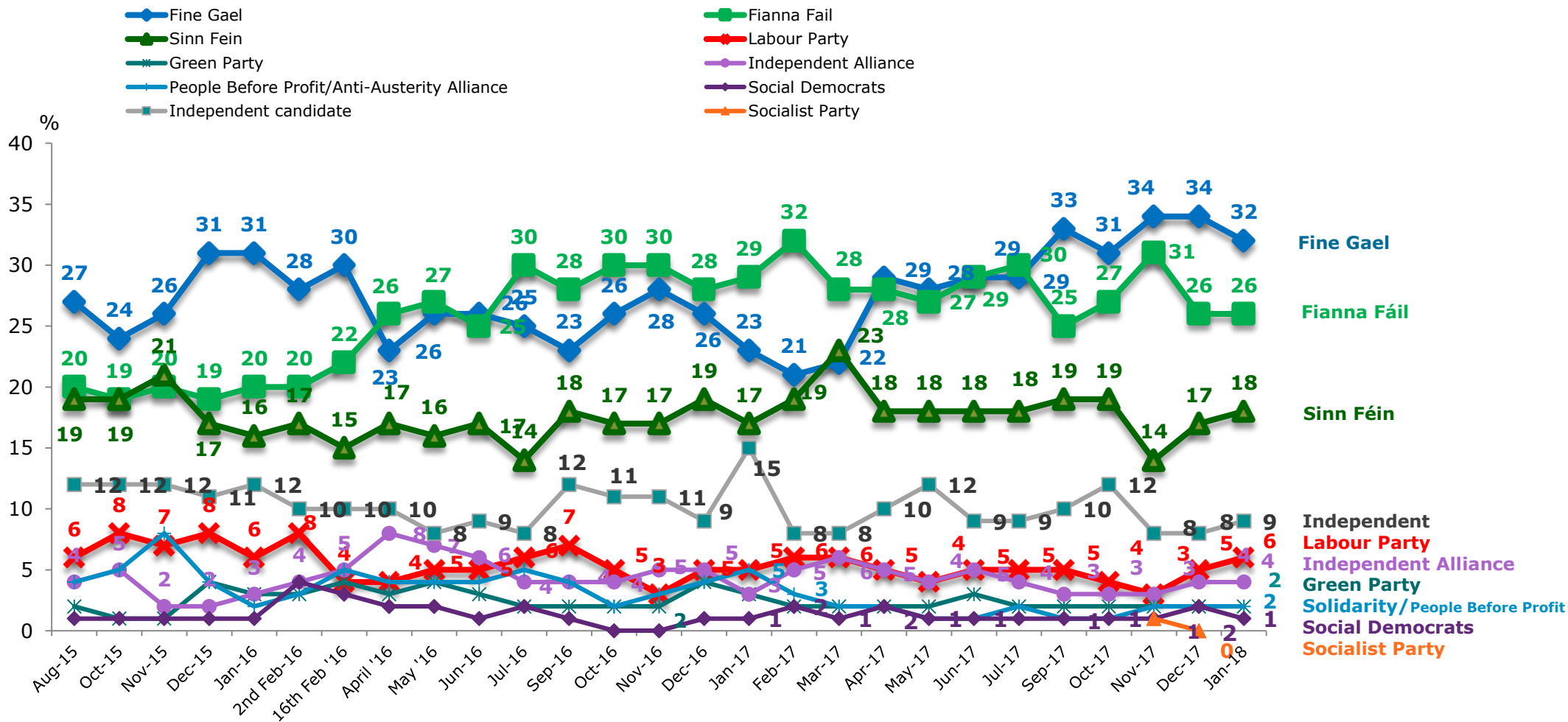

Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown (excluding undecided/adjusted)

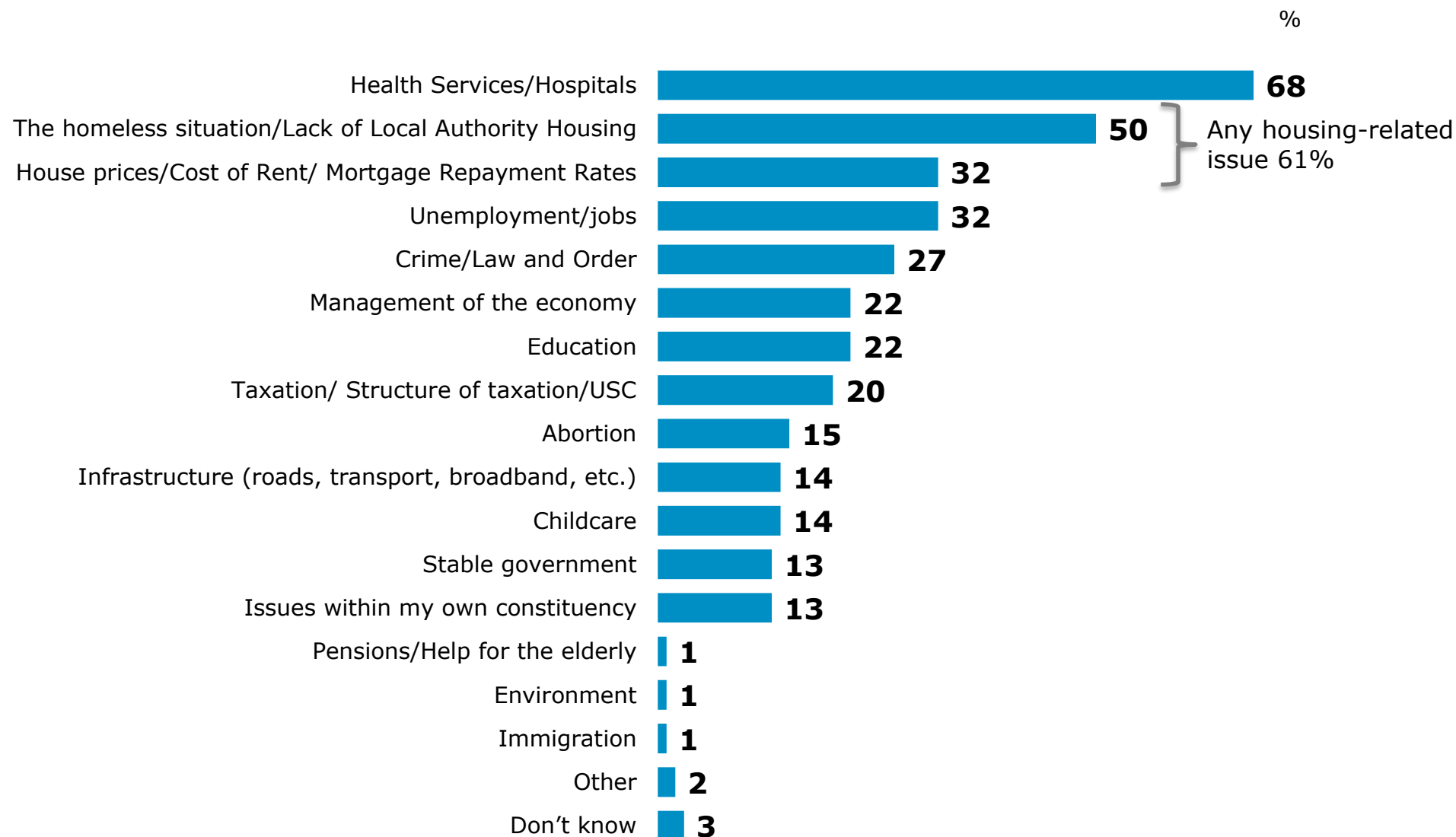


Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided – Adjusted)

Commentary

Background

Last month's Behaviour & Attitudes/Sunday Times Poll was conducted in the aftermath of negotiations on Phase 2 of the Brexit process, and the capitulation of Britain's negotiators on a series of issues, not least being the avoidance of a hard North/South border post-Brexit.

The results of that December Poll confirmed the public's satisfaction with Leo Varadkar's role in safeguarding Ireland's interests in those negotiations, and he regained his dominant position as most popular party leader in the country.

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Thursday 4th – Tuesday 16th January last, i.e. in advance of the resumption of the Dáil after the Christmas break.

There was significant media debate around the issue of lack of affordable housing and related issues to do with homelessness, over the two weeks leading up to the end of 2017.

By all accounts the housing crisis has risen towards the top of the list of voter concerns over a relatively short period of time, with no apparent strategy in place through which the issue can be resolved.

As we entered the first week of January, media attention turned to the health service, and specifically the all-time high of 677 hospital patients on trolleys waiting for beds as of Wednesday 3rd January.

Thus began the perennial debate as to the underlying causes of problems with the Irish health service in general, and the type of long lasting solutions required to improve it.

Background

Finally, as fieldwork for the poll progressed, public discourse was dominated by the forthcoming May Referendum on abortion, and the question as to the precise nature of the proposition that will be presented to voters on the matter.

At the time of writing, the Dáil debate in relation to the forthcoming abortion referendum is still ongoing. By the time next month's poll is conducted, all parties will have had a chance to air their views on the direction they feel the country should take regarding abortion, and it will be interesting to see what effect, if any, this dynamic will have on party support levels.

Following what had been a highly engaging period of political activity, including the near-collapse of the Government and precipitation of an election before Christmas, satisfaction levels with all party leaders increased between November and December.

In terms of pecking order, Leo Varadkar was the most popular party leader by the end of the year, followed very closely by Michael Martin, with both significantly more popular than Brendan Howlin, and Gerry Adams trailing behind on a satisfaction level of just 38%.

This month, satisfaction levels have settled back across the board to match those registered in November.

Critically, Leo Varadkar remains in the lead, with 52% satisfied with his performance as Taoiseach. Michael Martin remains in second place, just two percentage points behind Varadkar, with Brendan Howlin (42%) and Gerry Adams (37%) bringing up the rear.

44% of all voters are satisfied with the manner in which the Government is running the country – a figure which peaks amongst those aged 55 yrs+ (46%), and individuals from a white collar ABC1 working background (50%).

With regard to party support levels, there are no statistically significant differences between today's and last month's poll.

Thus, Fine Gael retains pole position at 32%, followed by Fianna Fáil on 26%, Sinn Féin on 18%, Independents and smaller parties on a combined 18%, and Labour on 6%.

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Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

As was the case last month, if these figures were replicated in a General Election a Fine Gael-led Rainbow Coalition including Labour, The Green Party and perhaps the Independent Alliance would be a distinct possibility.

The alternative, again based solely on today's figures, would appear to be a Fianna Fáil/Sinn Féin coalition – a grouping whose combined level of support currently stands at 44%.

Within these national party support figures there have been some minor movements month-on-month. For example, Fine Gael's support has actually decreased by 5 percentage points amongst females, and by 10 percentage points amongst older 55 yrs+ voters. Similarly, the party has decreased by 5 points across urban areas. Conversely, support for Fine Gael has improved by 7 points within the younger 18 to 34 years cohort, and by 2 points in rural areas.

Fianna Fáil support, meanwhile, has decreased marginally amongst younger voters and correspondingly increased amongst older respondents. Support for that party has also improved somewhat amongst the so-called ABC1 'middle class' (by 5 percentage points), and across urban areas (also by 5 percentage points).

While not statistically significant, Labour will be pleased to see its overall level of support increase from 5% in December to 6% this month – and to note what is a statistically significant growth in support from the low of 3% it reached last November to today's 6%. Labour will also be pleased to note that its support is very evenly distributed across all socio-demographic groupings, and that the party is well positioned in the Greater Dublin and Leinster regions, at a combined 8.5% support level across those areas.

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Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Sinn Féin support has increased by 5 points amongst female voters, and by a more modest 2 to 3 points amongst blue collar C2DE voters, residents of urban areas, and voters aged 35 yrs+.

All-in-all, therefore, the political landscape remains relatively unchanged since last month.

As mentioned in the introduction to this report, however, the 'Abortion Debate' has now only truly begun. We are facing into four months of what will likely be one of the most emotionally intense periods of Irish social history. While we cannot predict the outcome of this process, the stance adopted by the various political parties, and the manner in which they conduct their Referendum campaigns, is likely to significantly alter the political landscape between now and May as we enter truly uncharted waters.

Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes Opinion Poll Series

Issues/Concerns of Most Influence

As the prospect of a 2018 General Election appears more likely than not, we have introduced from this month an additional question to the polling series relating to the issues or concerns that are most likely to influence people's decision as to how they vote.

This question will be repeated periodically over the coming months, with a view to building up a sensitive monitor of the key factors which are shaping public opinion, and the specific types of voters each factor is more or less important to.

Respondents were not prompted with answer options at this question, so the factors of importance to them are generated at an entirely spontaneous level.

Respondents were given the opportunity to mention as many issues or concerns as they wished to, with the average voter identifying just over three key concerns which are most likely to influence their voting decision come the next General Election.

In response, Health, Housing & Homelessness, Jobs/The Economy, and Crime/Law & Order emerge as the issues of most concern to Irish citizens today.

Other areas mentioned by voters included Education, Abortion, Infrastructure, Childcare, the election of a Stable Government, and issues within their own constituency.

Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes Opinion Poll Series

Issues/Concerns of Most Influence

While these issues are of importance, to varying degrees, to people across the socio-demographic spectrum, some themes do emerge with regard to the pattern of response across different types of voters;

- ❖ Female voters tend to be more concerned than males about what might be termed social issues (i.e. Health, Homelessness, Education, Abortion and Childcare). Conversely, male voters are that bit more inclined than female voters to identify economic or infrastructural issues of importance (e.g. House Prices, Unemployment, Management of the Economy, Taxation and Infrastructure).
- ❖ Older voters (i.e. those aged 55 yrs+) are more inclined than other age groups to identify Health/The Health Service and Crime/Law & Order as being of concern to them. Respondents at pre-family or family stage are more likely to speak of concerns around House/Rent costs, Unemployment/Jobs, Education, Taxation, Abortion and Childcare.

Based on these figures, the next Election appears likely to hinge on Health, Housing and The Economy, and all candidates and parties will need to present the Electorate with compelling solutions to these challenges as part of their forthcoming manifestos.
