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# **Research Approach**



The research was conducted online. The target respondents were all adults aged 18+ nationwide.



Data was weighted to be nationally representative of those aged 18+ in Ireland.




The survey was quota controlled in terms of gender, age, region and social class to match known demographics of the population.



In all, 503 interviews were conducted from 30<sup>th</sup> October – 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2020.











43% of all adults used to go to live sporting events at least occasionally






#### **Report 5: Arts, Entertainment & Sport** There are differences by demographics with men missing the social side of the event more as well as the build up to the game itself.

# What are they missing most about not being able to attend live sporting events?



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



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


## Likelihood of attending sporting events in the future





⑦ Q.18 How willing or otherwise would you be to wear face coverings for the entire game while attending a professional live sporting event?








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# **Summary of key findings**



#### Background



- The profile is more male, middle class with Munster a stronghold.
- **86%** of us have gone to at least one live event.



#### What are sports enthusiast missing?

- The two main elements that sports enthusiasts are missing is the *excitement of* being at a live event and the *atmosphere* in the stadium.
- Out of 8 aspects measured, the average fan is missing <u>three</u> of them!



 Regular live sport attendees are a little different to the average in that what they miss most is the anticipation and build up to the event and over index on missing supporting their team.

#### What does the future hold?



- At the moment, 77% of regular attendees would consider attending a live sporting event but interestingly half of these would only do so if capacity stood at 50% or lower. Only just over 1 in 4 would return if capacity was at 75% or higher.
- The very large majority of these sporting enthusiasts are *happy to wear a face covering* for the duration of the match.
