### **Technical Appendix**



#### Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 943 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



#### **Fieldwork**

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an inhome, face-to-face basis over the period Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> September to Tuesday, 12<sup>th</sup> October.



#### Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



### **Technical Appendix**



#### Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



#### **Party Support**

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



#### Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

## Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.











#### Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> September to Tuesday, 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2021. It was conducted post the Coveney no confidence vote on 15<sup>th</sup> September, the resignation of MacSharry From Fianna Fáil and the further easing of restrictions from 20<sup>th</sup> September (e.g. phased return to workplaces, organised group activities, etc.). During the fieldwork period, various media were also reporting a robust economic recovery as the political parties geared up for budget day 12<sup>th</sup> October.

The mood of the nation was more positive, with the Chief Medical Officer not foreseeing any further lockdown, albeit not ruling out anything in the future should the trajectory change. This mood was in stark contrast to this time last year when a continued absence of a vaccine and the looming Christmas period were feeding into a general sense of gloom.

At the same time last year, Brexit negotiations were reaching the final stage, with growing business and consumer concern as to the likely impact of a no deal on their fortunes. As things stand, the 'B' word is rearing its head again.

All in all, a more positive mood was evident in the lead up to today's poll, with interviewing all but complete by the time the budget was announced on Tuesday, 12<sup>th</sup> October.



#### Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

In the run up to the budget, satisfaction with the Government remains at similar levels to last month's poll (and indeed this time last year), with four in ten currently happy with its performance. This represents a statistically insignificant decrease of two percentage points since September. Note the 40% satisfaction level is also ten percentage points higher than the rating the out-going Government received a month before the last General Election.

Higher levels of satisfaction with the Government exist amongst those aged 55+ years, with those in Leinster displaying significantly greater dissatisfaction. As in our last September poll, a small majority (52%) remain dissatisfied with the administration.

In terms of party leaders, Mary Lou McDonald remains the most popular leader with 49% of the electorate satisfied with her performance, a similar result to our last two polls. Her popularity is strong across all ages, with significantly higher ratings emanating from more blue collar working voter cohorts.

Micheál Martin is on a 42% satisfaction rating by the electorate, a slippage of three percentage points on September but he remains in second place. Leo Varadkar has not recovered from the drop in his ratings last month and stands at 39% satisfaction level with his performance. Both Martin and Varadkar have higher dissatisfaction levels among the 35-54 age cohort.

Eamon Ryan stands on a satisfaction rating of 31%, a three percentage points drop from September. Alan Kelly also drops three points to 41%.



#### Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Sinn Féin remain the most popular party, with about one-third (31%) of the electorate indicating it would vote for the party in the event of a General Election. This represents a statistically insignificant drop of two percentage points on our September poll. The party is particularly strong amongst those aged 18-54 years and across the different socio-economic cohorts of the population.

However, Fianna Fáil are edging ahead of Fine Gael for the first time since our 25<sup>th</sup> February 2020 poll, post the last General election; Fianna Fáil 23% (+2%) and Fine Gael 21% (-2%). Note while the movements are not statistically significant, the trend for Fine Gael has been downward over the last two Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes Polls (from 25% in June '21 to 21% today). Finally, there has been no change over the last two months in support for the Labour Party at 5% or the Green Party (5%).

The Government parties will be hoping the budget is received favourably by the electorate to help the quest to win back voters for their respective parties. Despite some clouds on the horizon the economic indicators bode well into 2022 and as we move to living with Covid, and rebuilding our lives, how the political parties define themselves over the next period will be crucial. It will be interesting to see how the Sinn Fein brand develops as it moves from challenger brand status to one of potential leadership. Such an evolution can be fraught with difficulties. Similarly too, Fianna Fail and Fine Gael need to have a clear point of differentiation, especially for 18-54 year old voters, with Dublin a particular challenge for Fianna Fáil. Next month will essentially be the acid test of the budget, once the media frenzy has settled, however we seem to be a long way from the next election (once the party defections don't accelerate).

## Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes Opinion Poll Series



#### **Attitudes towards Terminal Illness & Assisted Dying Legislation**

Two-thirds of the voting public support legislation that would allow people with terminal illness to end their life early in certain circumstances to avoid pain or suffering. One in five (20%) do not support, with a further 12% don't know/have no opinion. Support is significantly higher amongst those aged under 35 and those from more middle class, professional backgrounds. Rural dwellers and those aged 55+ years are significantly less likely to support, albeit 62% would still support the legislation.

Fianna Fáil supporters are least likely to support such legislation (59% support) with Sinn Féin (77%) and Green Party (83%) supporters being most in favour. The demographical divides on such issues represent a challenge to the more traditional parties with older voter bases.

Only one in ten (12%) of voters are of the opinion that someone who had assisted a terminally ill person to die with their full permission should be prosecuted. A very small vocal minority (18%) in rural areas are in favour of prosecution (compared to only 8% of urban dwellers).

On face value, a very clear picture of how people feel on these topics emerges. However these topics are highly emotional with complex nuances, which necessitate a wider debate.
