Technical Appendix

Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 933 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period Thursday 25th November to Wednesday 8th December, 2021.



Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.

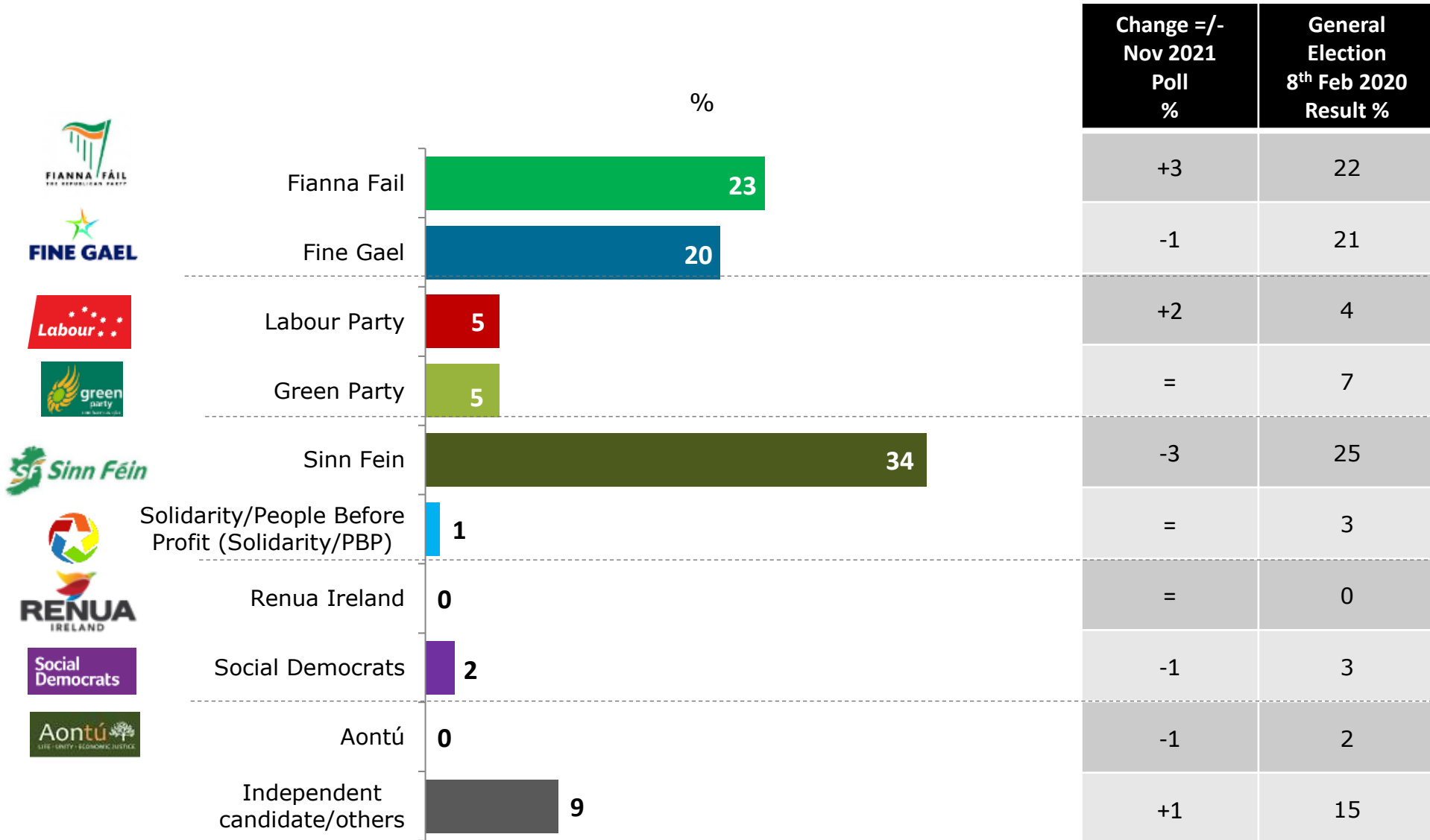

(excluding undecided/adjusted)



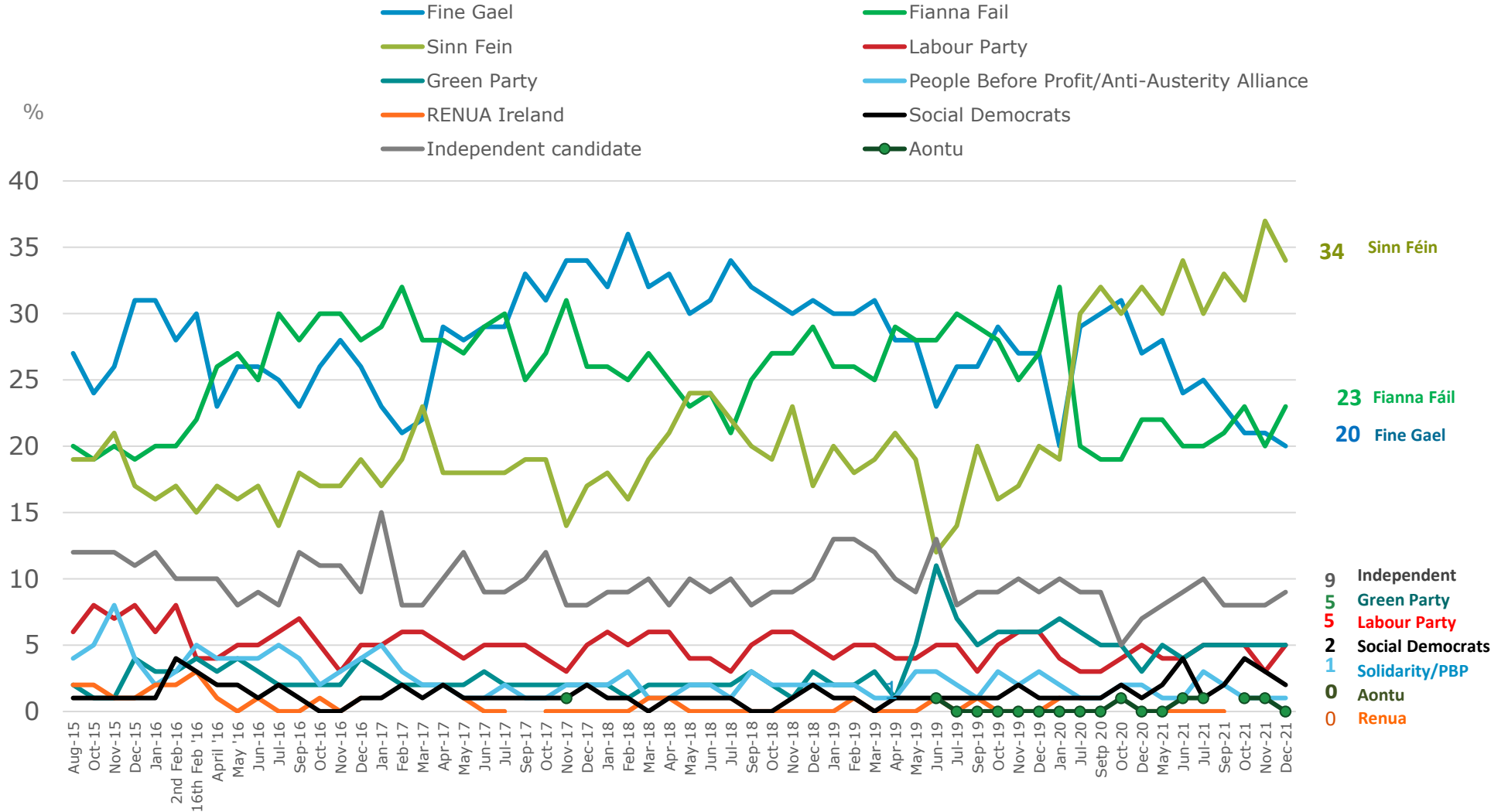

Commentary

Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Thursday 25th November to Wednesday 8th December 2021. This current Sunday Times/B&A poll was taken amidst a rising number of Covid cases and hospitalisations and a power struggle between NPHET and the Government.

The positivity emanating from the October 22nd announcement of the reopening of night clubs and relaxation of other restrictions lasted only weeks before the reintroduction of restrictions and the closing of nightclubs on 7th December.

In addition, schools and especially primary school children were a focal point, with some concerns around messaging and communications evident.

The public learnt of Omicron, the latest variant of concern, with advice on reducing social contacts, working from home, etc. causing uncertainty and anxiousness amongst an already weary public. This heightened sense of anxiety resulted in the public once more stepping up and adjusting their behaviour to stabilise the situation. For every action there is a reaction with the hospitality sector bearing the brunt of the impact. A flood of Christmas party cancellations was the overt reaction damaging an already depressed hospitality sector. Subsequent guidance to reduce capacity in venues also emerged.

Thus, despite a growing economic recovery, the public was being bombarded by Covid, looking to once again salvage some form of Christmas, while wondering what will January 2022 hold (in Covid terms).

The public are battle worn and tired, yet still for the most part are trying to do the right thing.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Given the fixation on Covid, it is probably no surprise that results are broadly similar for November. People's attention was focused on Covid and getting to and through Christmas. Satisfaction with the Government remains at similar levels to last month's poll, with four in ten (40%) currently happy with its performance. However as the point was made last month, this has been slipping since June when it stood at 47% satisfaction levels. About half (52%) remain dissatisfied with the current Government.

In terms of party leaders, Mary Lou McDonald remains the most popular leader with 48% of the electorate satisfied with her performance. It has softened from the high on the last poll which was most likely associated with their Ard Fheis, but is consistent with levels recorded throughout 2021. Her popularity is strong across all ages, with even higher ratings emanating from under 35 year old voters. Her satisfaction is weaker amongst the rural voter, compared to urban and those aged 55+ years.

Micheál Martin is on a 42% satisfaction rating (down from his annual high of 50% in June) by the electorate, an insignificant increase of one percentage point on November, but he remains in second place. Leo Varadkar has still not recovered from the drop in his ratings in September and stands at 39% satisfaction level. Eamon Ryan stands on a satisfaction rating of 29%, down slightly on last month. Alan Kelly remains on 38% satisfaction.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Sinn Féin support has softened slightly as expected on their post Ard Fheis score last wave, with 34% of the electorate indicating it would vote for the party in the event of a General Election. They remain the most popular party. The party is strong amongst all demographics, but particularly amongst those aged 18-34 years and more blue collar socio-economic cohorts of the population.

Fianna Fáil has edged ahead of Fine Gael again with 23%, Fine Gael stand at 20%. Note while the movements for the latter parties are not statistically significant, this represents an increase of three percentage points for Fianna Fáil, and a decrease of one percentage point for Fine Gael. Labour has increased by two percentage points to 5%. The Green's remain on 5%.

As we enter 2022, it will be interesting to see how the country evolves to 'live' with Covid and who can best communicate a future vision for Ireland. The party(s) that can communicate a confident strategy while addressing the societal challenges facing the country, will capture the hearts and minds of the public. It will be a time for confident leadership, with an empathetic tone.
