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### **Technical Appendix**



### **Sample Size**

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 938 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 29<sup>th</sup> September to 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2022.

### Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.









## **Technical Appendix**



### Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



### **Party Support**

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



### Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

# Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.



(excluding undecided/adjusted)





# Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes Opinion Poll Series



### **Background**

- The fieldwork for this latest Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes Poll was conducted between 29<sup>th</sup> September 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2022, in the weeks post the budget.
- Inflationary pressures continued to dominate the headlines, with many energy companies continuing to increase prices. Commentary was evident about price hikes potentially wiping out budget giveaways.
- Mixed messages on the wider world economy were being reported and while many were citing no Irish recession, rather a slow down, the usual caveats on world impacts were being stressed.
   During this period a slowdown of property prices was evident.
- The new British PM endured a difficult start to her leadership, with the UK budget being poorly received, and markets reacting negatively.
- The war in Ukraine continued to rage with the Russian annexation of Ukrainian regions being denounced by world leaders, while Ukrainian forces launched a successful counter-offensive.
   Fears surrounding some form of Nuclear escalation were being stoked by various sides during this period.
- At home, Ireland's Future Conference appeared well attended from across the political spectrum.
- The Friday before our poll ended, the terrible tragedy of the explosion in Creeslough rocked the nation. The outpouring of grief and support clearly symbolised the positive essence of Irish culture.

# Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes Opinion Poll Series



### **Government and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

- Current Government satisfaction now stands at 42% of the population satisfied with its performance (a significant six percentage points increase on our September poll). Note this poll was conducted post the budget. About half (51%) are dissatisfied with the current Government (down six percentage points). Satisfaction levels with the Government remain higher amongst older (55+) voters.
- Mary Lou McDonald's satisfaction rating has returned to 49% (two percentage points up on September). She holds onto the most popular leader title, by the slimmest of margins (1%).
- Micheál Martin's satisfaction rating also increased by two percentage points to 48%.
- Leo Varadkar's satisfaction level has also increased by two points from 40% last wave to 42%.
- Eamon Ryan's satisfaction rating has increased significantly from 26% to 31%. This is no mean feat in an energy crisis.
- Ivana Bacik's rating has recovered from her dip in September to register her highest satisfaction rating of 47%.
- If this poll is to be regarded as a score card on the budget and the handling of the current crisis so far, then the result is positive for the Government. Obviously people, especially certain cohorts, are still concerned about the cost-of-living crisis.

### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

- Sinn Féin's support stands at 34% (down one percentage point-not significant), and they remain the most popular party.
- Fianna Fáil stands at 22% (an decrease of two percentage points not significant).
- Fine Gael has seen an increase of one percentage point from 20% to 21% (not significant).
- Labour reversed their two point hit in September, increasing to 6%.
- The Green Party stand at 4% level of support (-1%).
- The Social Democrats are at 2% support.
- This poll was in effect an assessment of the Government budget, and the handling of the current energy crisis (at this point in time).
- It is likely that the full impact of the crisis has yet to be felt as we head into the Winter months. Undoubtedly there is uncertainty in people's minds about the coming months and what the crisis will look like and how it will evolve. This is not a familiar playbook, and blame appears to lie on the East. At this stage much of people's hopes are pinned on Government interventions taking the bite out of the impact.
