Technical Appendix

Technical Appendix

- The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 898 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.
- As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.
- Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 1st – 11th May, 2016.
- The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.

Technical Appendix

- The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).
- Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.
- All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.

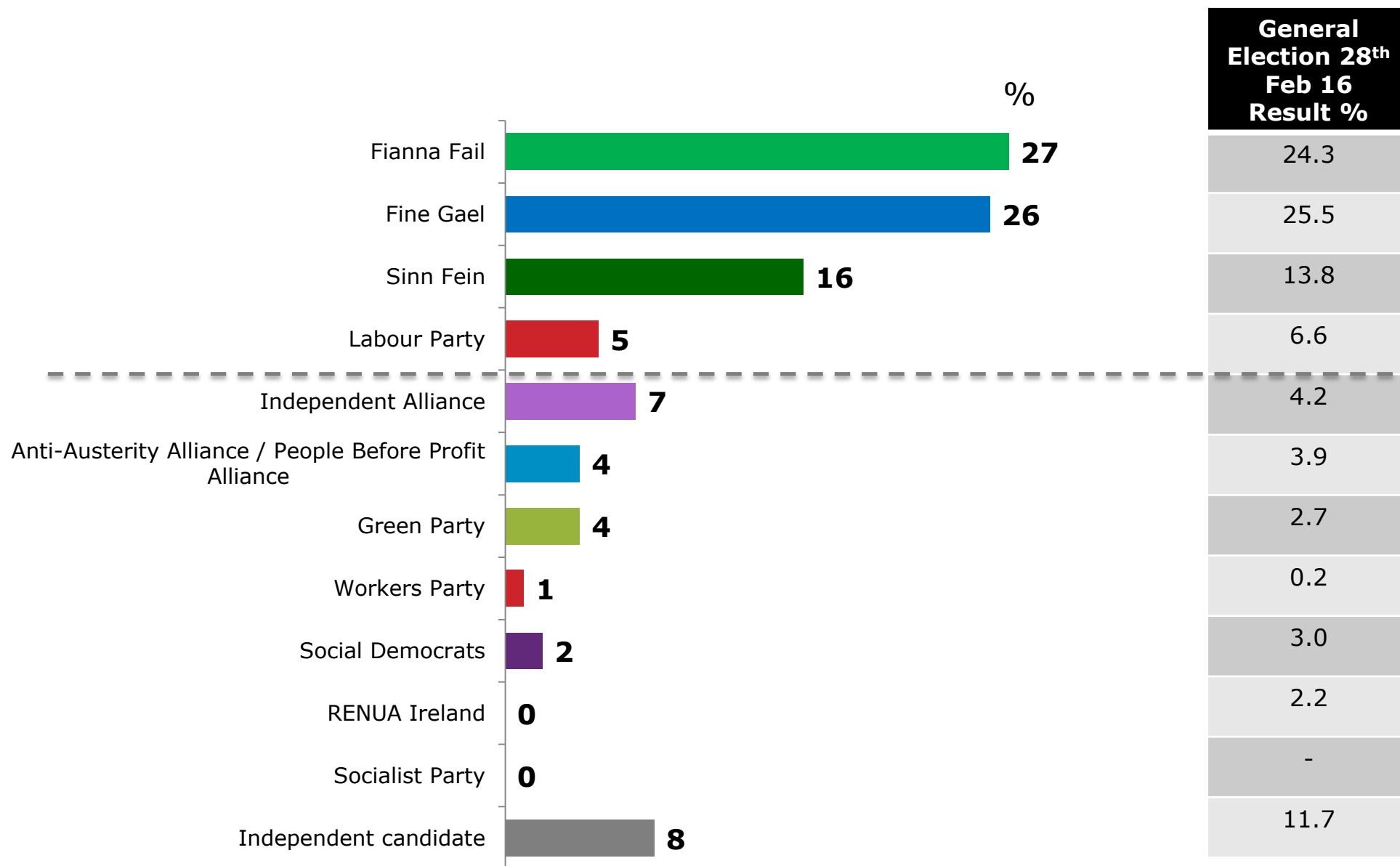

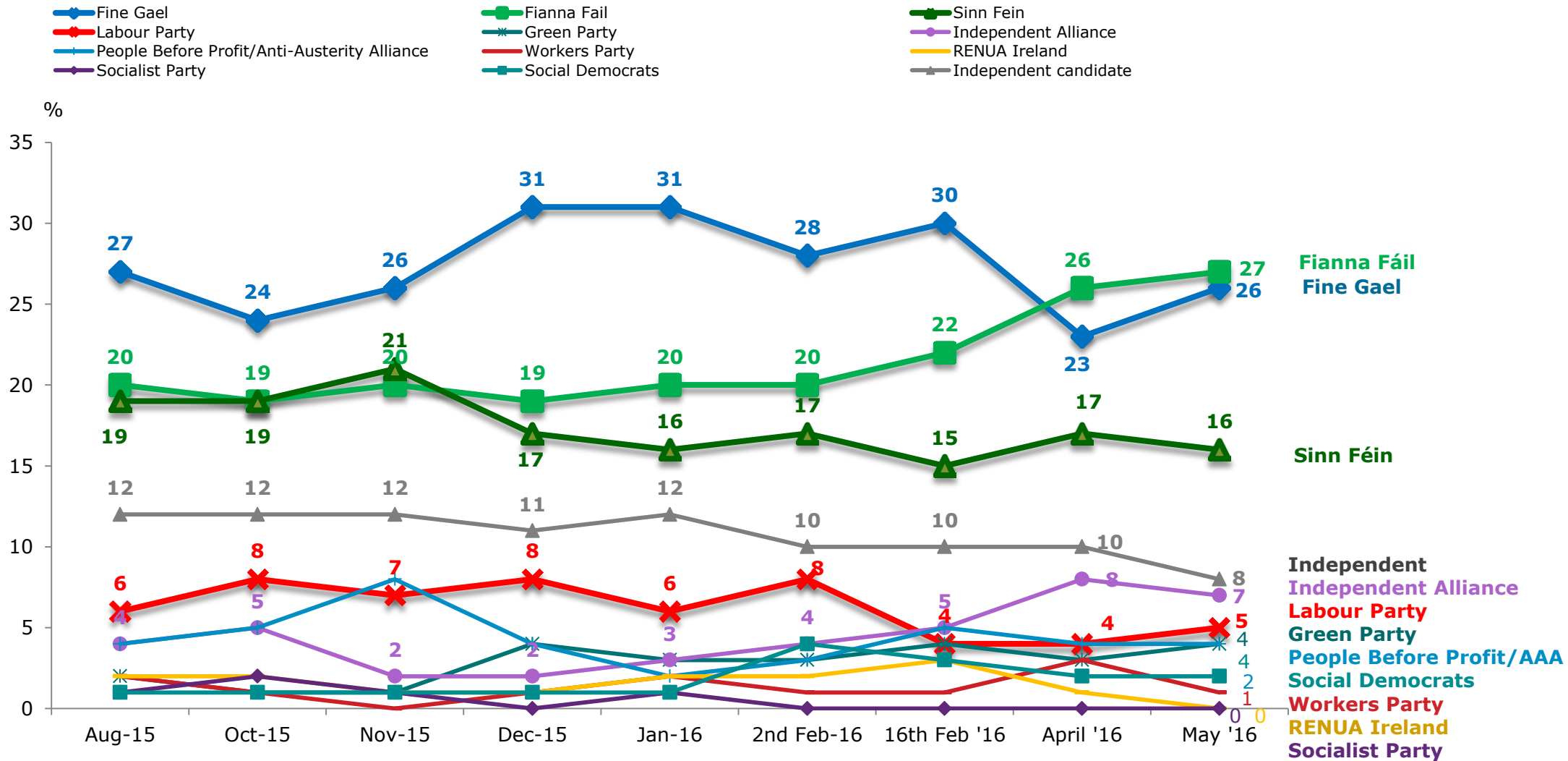

Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown (excluding undecided/adjusted)

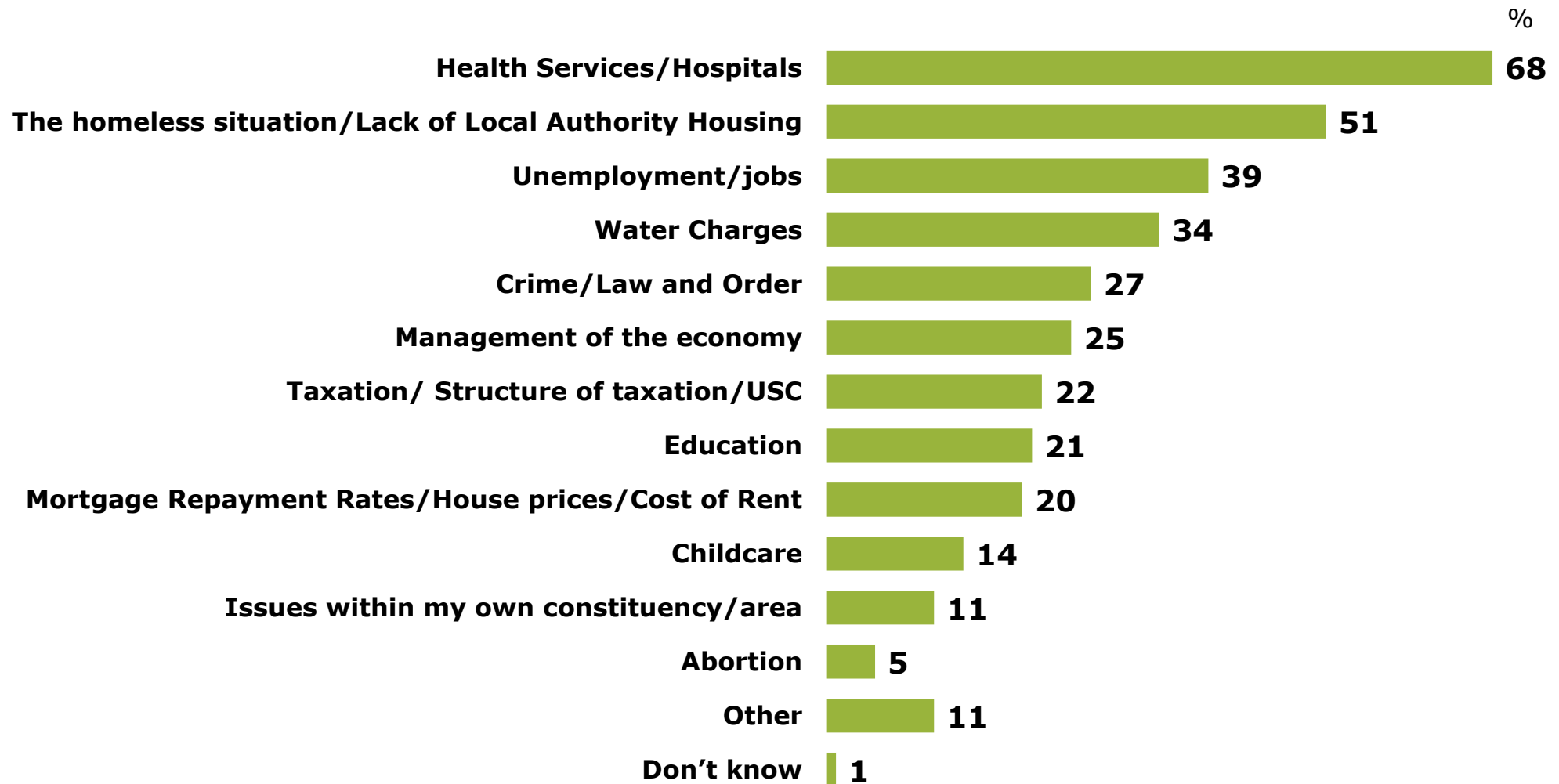


Party Support Levels – Detailed Breakdown Trend (Excluding Undecided – Adjusted)

Commentary

Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes Opinion Poll Series

Background

Fieldwork for last month's poll was conducted at a time when a caretaker administration was in office, rendering such questions as Government, Taoiseach and Tánaiste satisfaction ratings somewhat redundant.

Interviewing for today's poll was split roughly 50:50 between those interviewed prior to our new Government composition being announced, and after that announcement.

Again, we should therefore treat the party leader and Government satisfaction ratings with a pinch of salt – as the true performance of the new Government will take at least another few months for the Electorate to ascertain.

Interviewing would have been conducted in the midst of reactions to Gerry Adam's inexplicable use of the 'N' word in a late night tweet, while the great majority of survey work would have been finalised by the time Joan Burton announced her resignation as leader of the Labour Party.

Undoubtedly, the most potent dynamic influencing the views of the Electorate for today's poll will however have been the final machinations between Fine Gael, Fianna Fáil and Independent TDs as they hammered out the bones of a deal in the formation of a minority Fine Gael Government.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Given the state of flux within which the survey was conducted, it is probably no surprise that satisfaction with the manner in which the Government is running the country stands at just 24% this month; broadly on a par with the 22% registered in April.

Indeed, two-thirds of the electorate was actively dissatisfied with the Government's performance – a proportion which rises to three-quarters of the most financially hard-pressed cohort of 35 to 54 year old voters.

Micheál Martin remains as the most popular party leader in the country – with 76% of core Fianna Fáil supporters happy with the way in which he is doing his job as leader of their party. Satisfaction with Gerry Adams as leader of Sinn Féin continues to slide, and at just 30% in today's poll is at its lowest level since the inception of the Sunday Times/Behaviour & Attitudes polling series.

In terms of party support, Fianna Fáil has increased insignificantly by one percentage point to 27% support today – its highest ever in the polling series. Support for Fianna Fáil has actually dropped since last month amongst the 35 to 54 years age group, but has increased significantly amongst 18 to 34 year olds and older 55 years+ voters. Its support has also increased significantly amongst the white collar and professional working ABC1 cohort, but dropped quite markedly amongst the C2DE 'working class' constituency.

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Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Fine Gael will also be pleased to note that its level of support has increased three percentage points over the last four weeks to 26% - the very same share of the vote it garnered in February's election, and positioning them neck-and-neck with Fianna Fáil as the biggest party in the country.

The increase in Fine Gael support has been relatively evenly distributed across the age groups, although is somewhat higher for working individuals in Dublin, and also voters in rural areas.

As it embarks upon its quest for a new leader, the Labour party should take some solace from its 11% support in Dublin, although it will of course be aiming to significantly improve upon its national support level of 5% over the coming months.

Support for Sinn Féin, which has consciously placed itself outside public discourse around the formation of a Government, today stands at 16%, which is more or less in line with its share of the first preference vote in the General Election.

Finally, we witnessed today a significant drop in support for the Independents/smaller parties (from 27% to 22%), a sign perhaps that the recent post-Election uncertainty has caused some voters to doubt the wisdom of voting for such candidates.

Voter Concerns

Towards the end of the interview, respondents were asked to indicate to the surveyor what they felt were the main issues or problems the new Government should focus on over the next year or two.

Note, respondents were not presented with a list of options at this question, but rather were given free rein to mention the specific issues they felt the Government should address, with the responses of all respondents then grouped together under specific headings at analysis stage.

In addition, respondents could nominate more than one issue at this question, with the average number of areas of concern identified emerging as 3.5 per respondent – a sign in itself that expectations will be high of this new Government as it tackles what is perceived to be a plethora of issues that need to be resolved by them sooner rather than later.

It will come as no surprise that the issue of single greatest concern to the electorate is that of the health service/hospitals, with almost seven in ten of all potential voters nominating it on an unprompted basis. Female voters, those aged over 55 years, and voters living in rural areas are particularly exercised by problems with the Health Service, and there will undoubtedly be enormous interest in the proposed ten year plan for the sector when it is published by Minister Harris in due course.

Perhaps surprisingly, the issue of second greatest concern is that of the homeless situation/ lack of Local Authority Housing, a topic which was spontaneously mentioned by 51% of the electorate as a key priority.

This subject is perceived to be particularly acute in the Dublin area, where 60% of all voters nominate it as an area requiring Government attention.

From a party political perspective, it is interesting to note that supporters of Fine Gael are marginally more inclined to nominate economic issues as being important to themselves than are supporters of all of the other parties.

Conversely, supporters of Sinn Féin, Independents and the Labour Party are more likely to highlight issues to do with the Health Service and housing, as well as unemployment and water charges.
