Technical Appendix

Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 928 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 24th February – 8th March, 2022.



Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



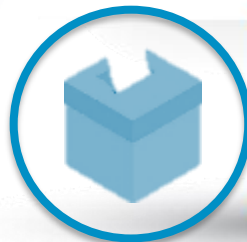
Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.

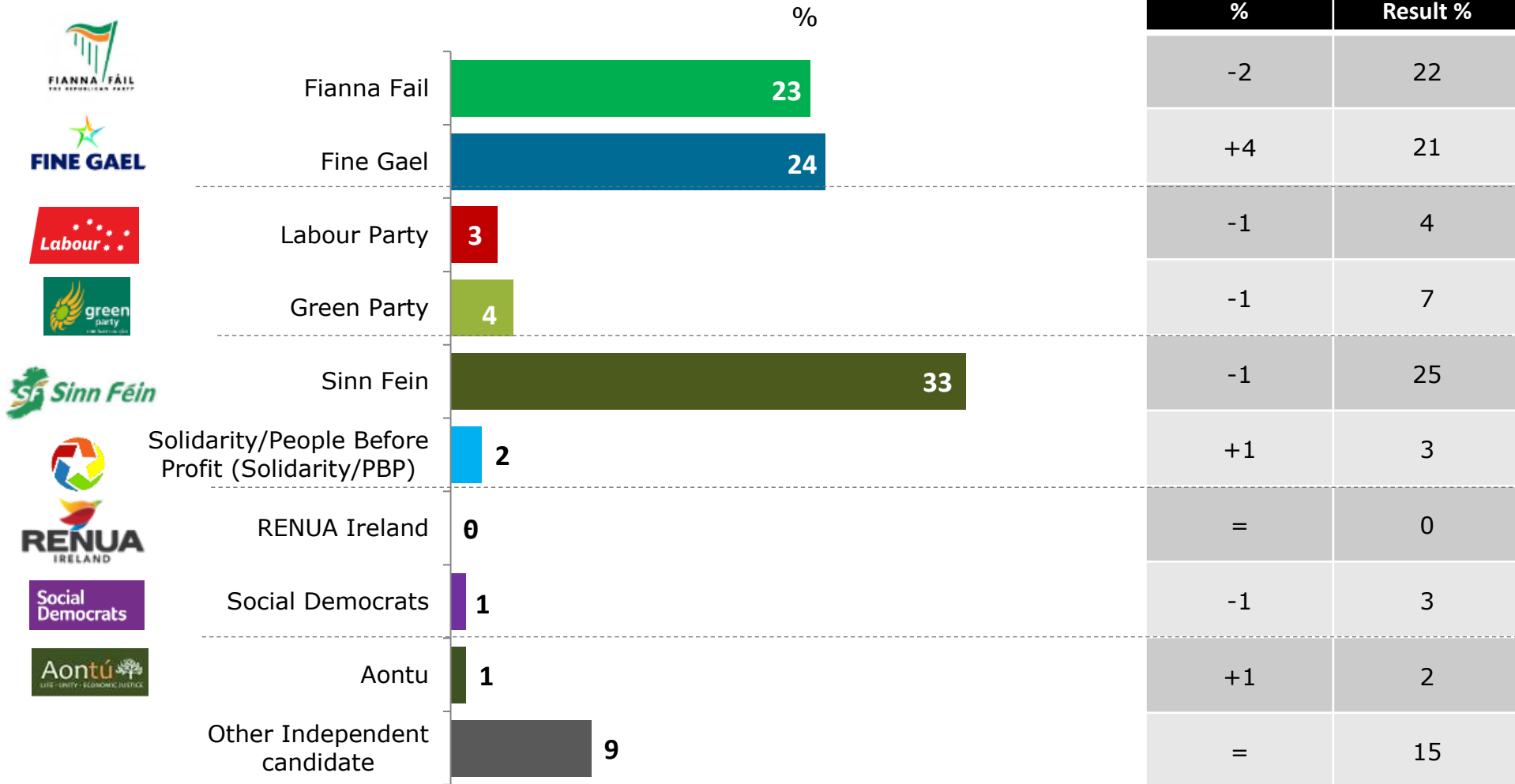

(excluding undecided/adjusted)

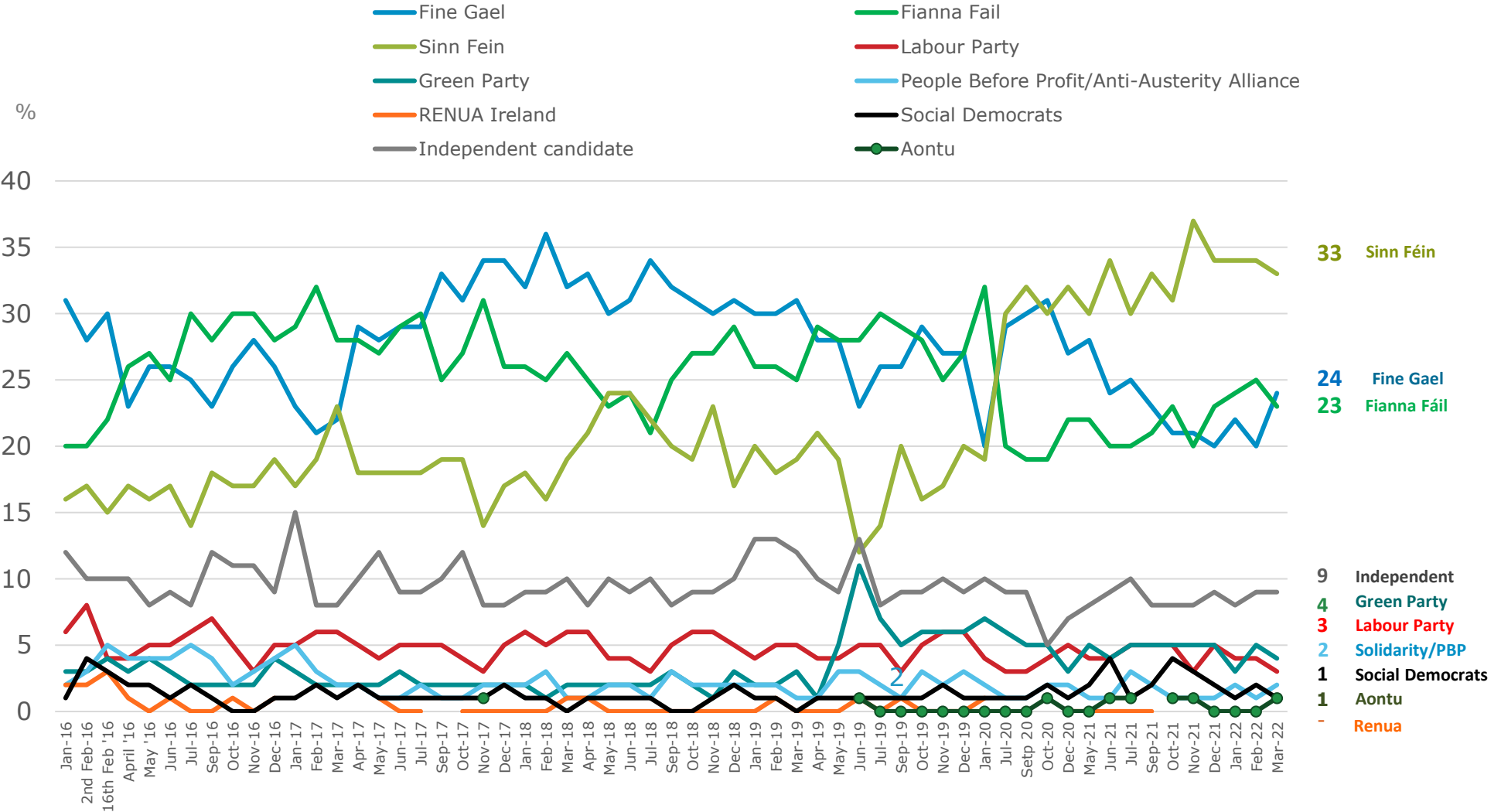

Commentary

Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Thursday the 24th February to Tuesday the 8th of March 2022.

During this period, the focus shifted somewhat from the Covid crisis to the Ukrainian war. Over the course of the poll, the war gained top billing with western nations starting to implement some of the strongest sanctions ever applied against a country.

Midway through this poll on the 2nd March, Alan Kelly resigned the Labour Party leadership. Thus, his ratings in this poll must be considered within this context. A new leader has yet to be appointed, however Ivana Bacik appears to be the sole runner.

On the Covid front the number of hospitalisations stabilised in late February, with less frequent reporting. However, Michael D. Higgins testing positive for Covid-19 serves as a timely reminder that Covid has not gone away, despite the deluge of Ukrainian War content.

During this period, inflation continued to rise in Ireland, with the Republic's prices being cited as 40% above the EU average according to CSO figures. As our poll ended, petrol and diesel hit €2 in some fuel forecourts.

The impact of the war on Irish people's lives is likely to be prominent over the next number of months, with the cost of living increasing, refugees arriving, and supply chains disrupted and even cut. How long the Ukrainian War lasts and whether it expands or not, will ultimately dictate the impact. Energy rationing might yet be a feature in the coming months.

Government and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Government satisfaction is down three percentage points (not significant) from February and stands at 43%. Overall, we see a settling back of scores from the initial euphoria of restriction relaxation. Half (48%) remain dissatisfied with the current Government. Satisfaction levels with the Government are higher amongst older and more middle class voters with blue collar cohorts remaining significantly less satisfied.

In line with the softening in Government satisfaction, both Micheál Martin and Leo Varadkar see their satisfaction ratings ease back slightly (albeit not significantly) in March. Both Micheál Martin and Leo Varadkar's ratings have decreased by 2 percentage points, with Micheál Martin's decreasing to 49% while Leo Varadkar's decreased to 42%.

Mary Lou McDonald's satisfaction rating has declined 4 percentage points from 51% to 47%. This results in Micheál Martin edging ahead on the most popular leader title (both were on 51% satisfaction in February).

Eamon Ryan's satisfaction stands at 34%, similar to the February poll (up one percentage point). Alan Kelly's satisfaction declines to 39%, however note he resigned as Labour leader on March 2nd during this poll.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Sinn Féin support continues to remain relatively steady, with 33% of the electorate indicating they would vote for the party in the event of a General Election, and they remain by far the most popular party, albeit declining by one percentage point.

Fine Gael has seen the greatest uplift in the past month with 24% of the electorate likely to vote for this party in the event of a General Election (up four percentage points). Fianna Fail stand at 23% (down two percentage points – not significant). Labour are down one percentage point to 3%. The Green Party drop one percentage point and now stand at 4% support.

In February we were discussing Covid taking a backseat, and the cost of living becoming more important. Concern around the cost of living has accelerated with prices continuing to inflate in many areas. Supply chains were already straining due to Covid, and the Ukrainian conflict will only serve to accentuate the challenges of inflationary prices and access to goods. The invasion has already dented Irish consumer confidence (as can be seen in recent B&A Confidence Barometer).

As we undertake our 2022 Census on 3rd April it will be interesting to ascertain the make up of our society with the likely influx of Ukrainian refugees. Debates on defence and neutrality are already surfacing, as global defence spend increases. As alluded to previously, this war is likely to have a profound social and cultural impact, the extent of which depends on how long it continues and how wide it becomes.

It will be interesting to see the performance of the Taoiseach and the broader Government in a 'war' footing versus more left leaning parties over the next while. Even by political standards the amount of challenges being thrown at the country has undoubtedly been extreme.
