# Technical Appendix

## Sample Size

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 908 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years+.



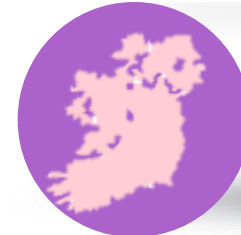
## Fieldwork

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an in-home, face-to-face basis over the period 28<sup>th</sup> April to 10<sup>th</sup> May 2022



## Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.



# Technical Appendix

## Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



## Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



## Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

# Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.

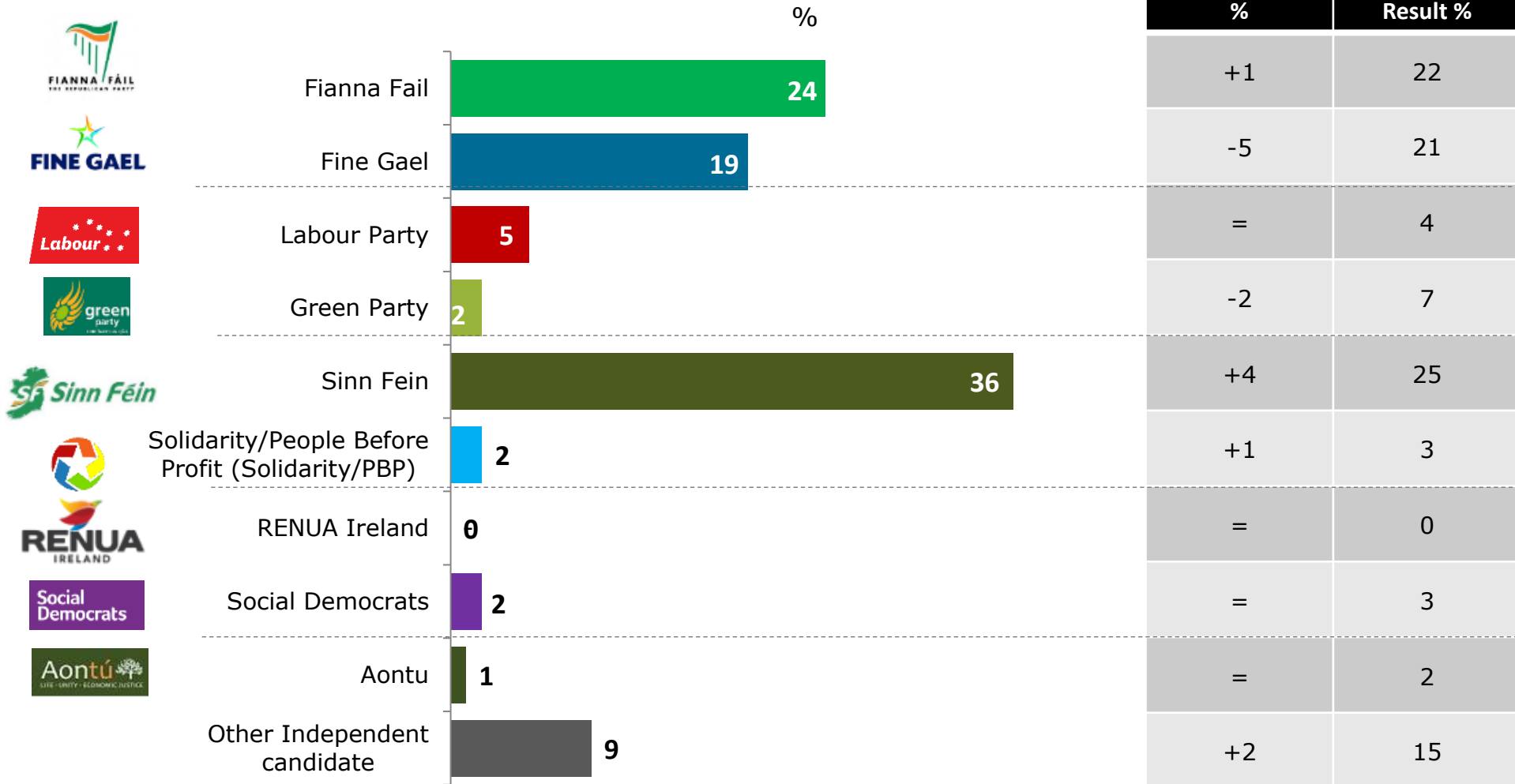

(excluding undecided/adjusted)

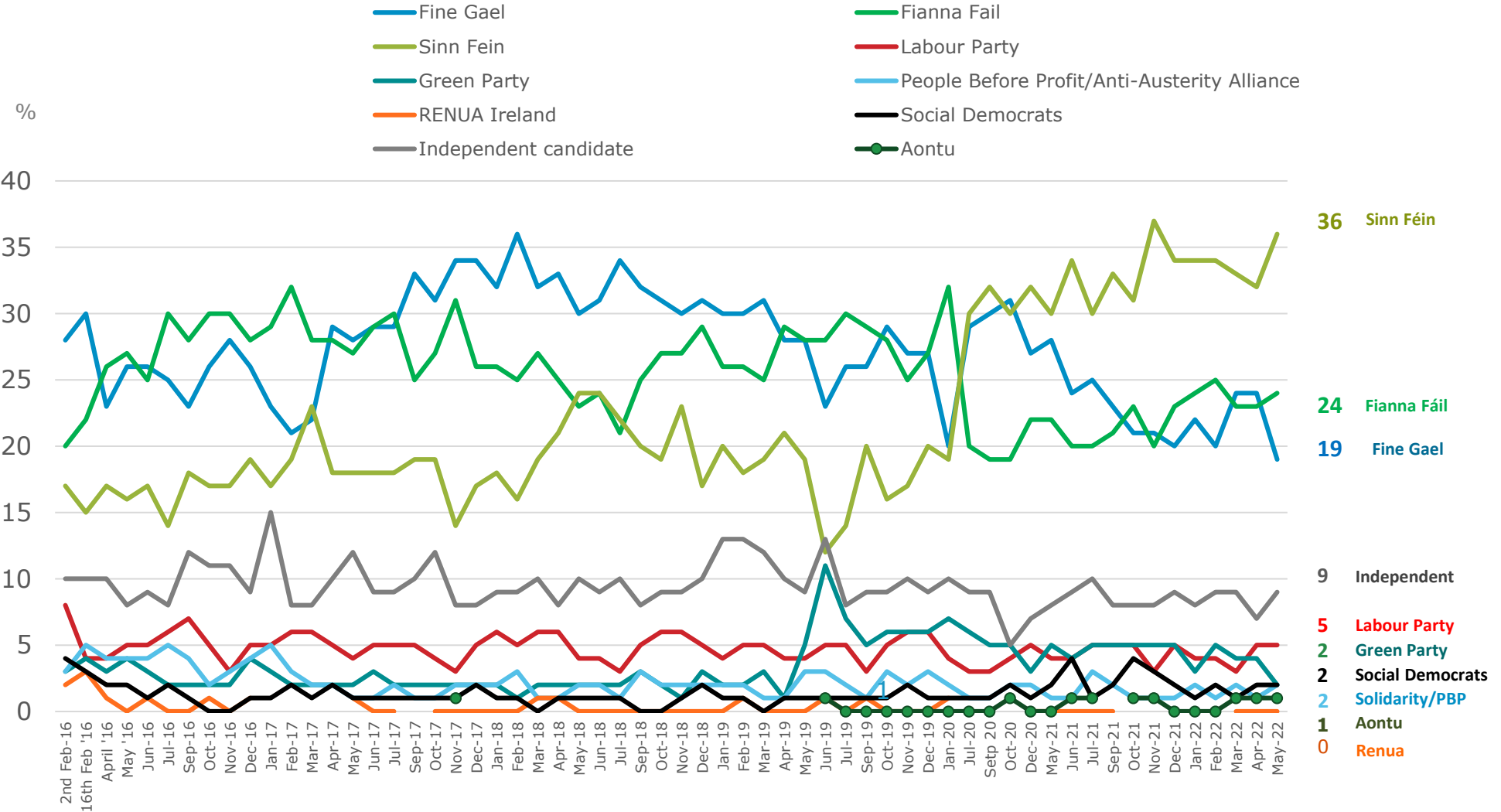

# Commentary

## Background

- This poll was conducted 28<sup>th</sup> April – 10<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at the time when the Ukraine war and its fallout continued to dominate the headlines. Seventy days of war were marked during our polling period, with the extent of its brutality emerging daily. The airing on Russian state TV of the consequences of a nuclear strike on the UK (and Ireland) sent a chilling reminder of how easily a third World War could escalate, and its devastating consequences. Refugees continued to arrive in Ireland, with vacant social homes being signalled for refugees. As officials from various nations continued to visit the Ukraine, Bono and The Edge added their heft by playing an underground gig.
- Closer to home this poll was conducted in the run up to the Northern Ireland Assembly elections, with projections indicating and ultimately leading to Sinn Féin gaining the largest share of the first preference vote, with the Alliance party also making gains.
- Minister Ryan’s Turf saga stirred up some rural angst.
- The focus on Covid subsided, with the release of case numbers becoming less frequent. However, the Holohan ‘appointment’ continued to rumble on with Robert Watt and Dr Tony Holohan appearing at the Oireachtas Health Committee.



## Background

- Against this background, Inflation is at its highest for many decades with the Ukraine war driving up energy and food prices. The CSO indicated that Ireland's inflation rate rose to 7.3% in April from 6.9% the previous month. This rate compares with an average of 7.5% across the whole of the eurozone. The ESRI have projected that inflation will peak around 8% in the summer, before easing towards the end of the year. However, the fallout is likely to impact well into 2023.
- In addition, we have potential interest rate rises to look forward to this year. Thus, it is not surprising that consumer confidence continued to take a hit, despite the good performance of the economy and unemployment levels approaching pre pandemic levels. A degree of uncertainty and nervousness is clearly evident at the moment. Hence, the importance of language and how the public are communicated with over the next period.

## Government and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Government satisfaction is steady at 44% of the population satisfied with its performance (no change from April). Half (49%) remain dissatisfied with the current Government. Satisfaction levels with the Government are higher amongst older (55+), and Dublin voters, while those aged 35-54 and more rural cohorts are significantly less satisfied.

Micheál Martin's satisfaction rating increases two percentage points to 51%. He retains the most popular leader title; just ahead of Mary Lou McDonald who has closed the gap to 1 percentage point.

Mary Lou McDonald's satisfaction rating has increased by three percentage points from 49% to 52%.

Leo Varadkar's rating also increases two percentage points to 44%.

Eamon Ryan's satisfaction rating, which had dropped significantly from 34% to 28% in the last poll, has not recovered and remains at 28%. The 'turf' saga and the compounding discussions around 'driving slower', conserving home energy and the Carbon Tax, in conjunction with energy prices rises over the past few months are likely to have impacted his scores.

Ivana Bacik's second outing is a 48% satisfaction rating, placing her satisfaction rating ahead of Leo Varadkar in her early days at the helm. Her rating is not surprisingly highest amongst Dubliners (60%).

## Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Given their success in the Northern Ireland assembly elections, it is not surprising that Sinn Féin support has increased by four percentage points to 36% of the electorate stating they would vote for them in the event of a General Election. They are by far the most popular party in the Republic, in addition to now being the largest Party in Northern Ireland.

Fine Gael has seen a significant drop in support of five percentage points from 24% to 19% (back to early February levels). Fianna Fail stand at 24% (drop of one percentage point). Labour are stable on 5%. The Green Party are under pressure too with support halving to a 2% support level – (down two percentage points).

Undoubtedly, inflation and resultant concern around the cost of living is impacting views in general. The fundamental issues impacting 'day to day' lives (i.e. cost of living, food, energy prices, housing and health) will be the 'battleground' for the foreseeable future. It is also likely that the hardships being experienced have not yet peaked. Political parties will need to realise that not everyone is being impacted equally, with some cohorts still doing well, while others are suffering badly. Indeed, the INMO report of some nurses relying on food banks might not be the last such story of hard pressed cohorts.
