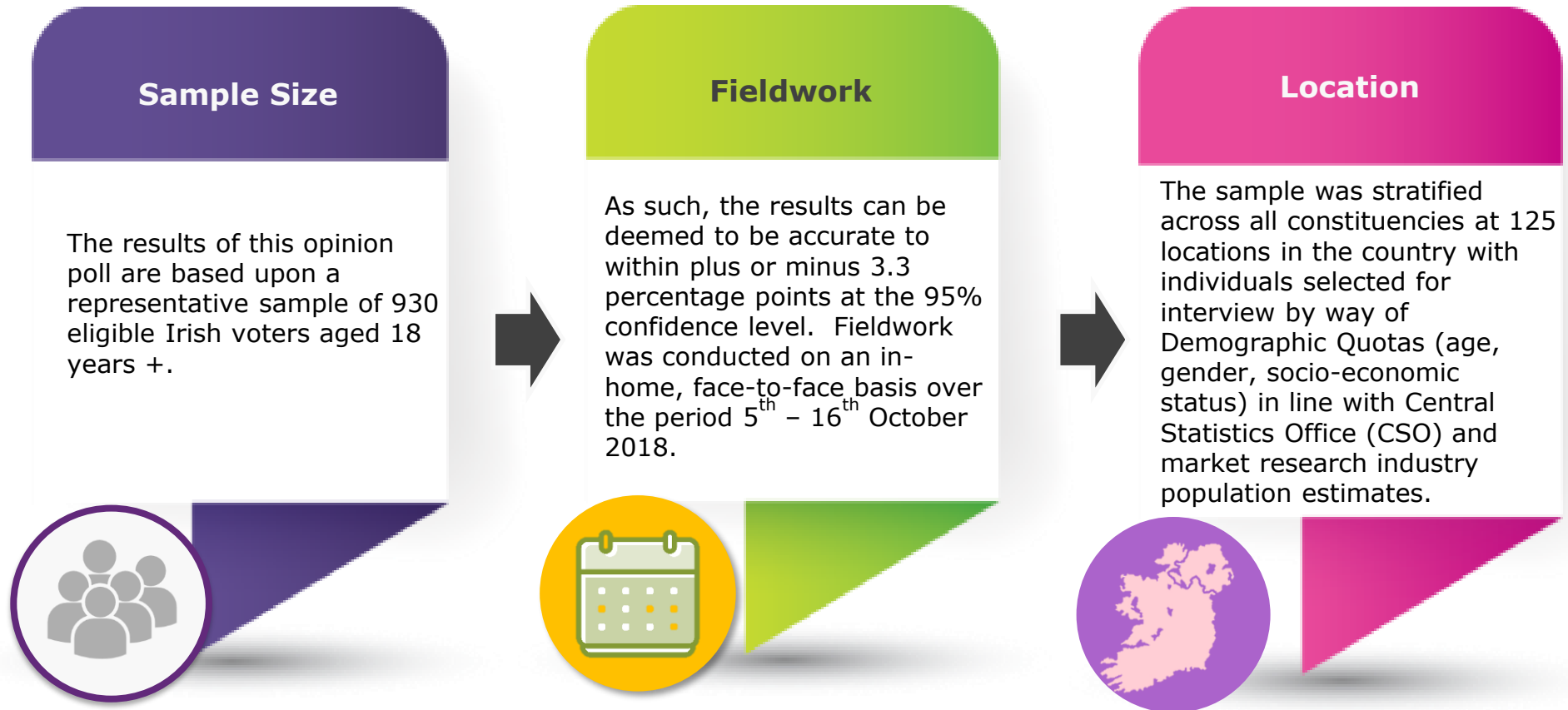

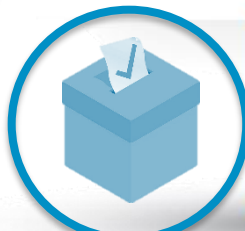
Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



Party Support

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



Guidelines

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.

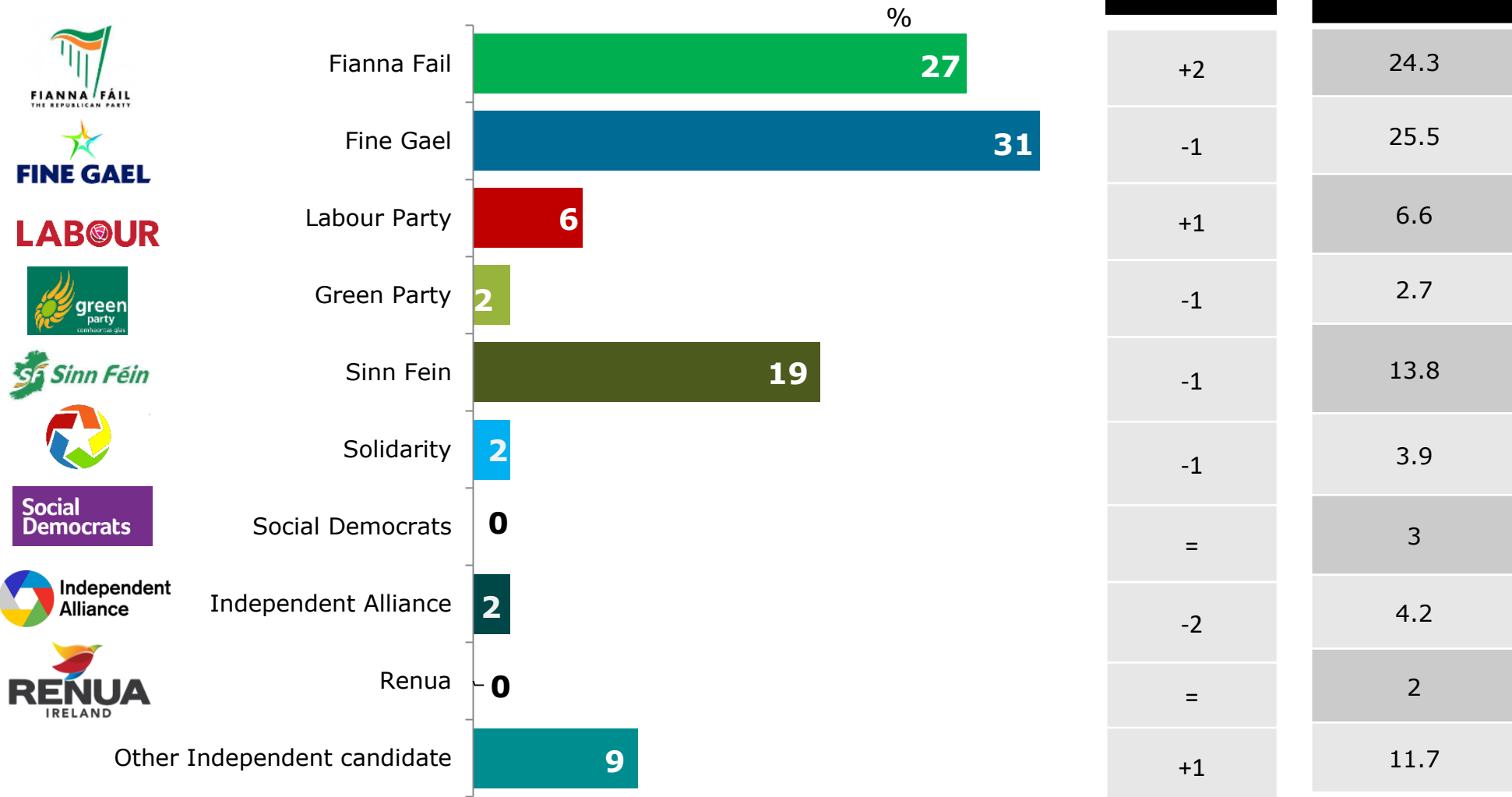

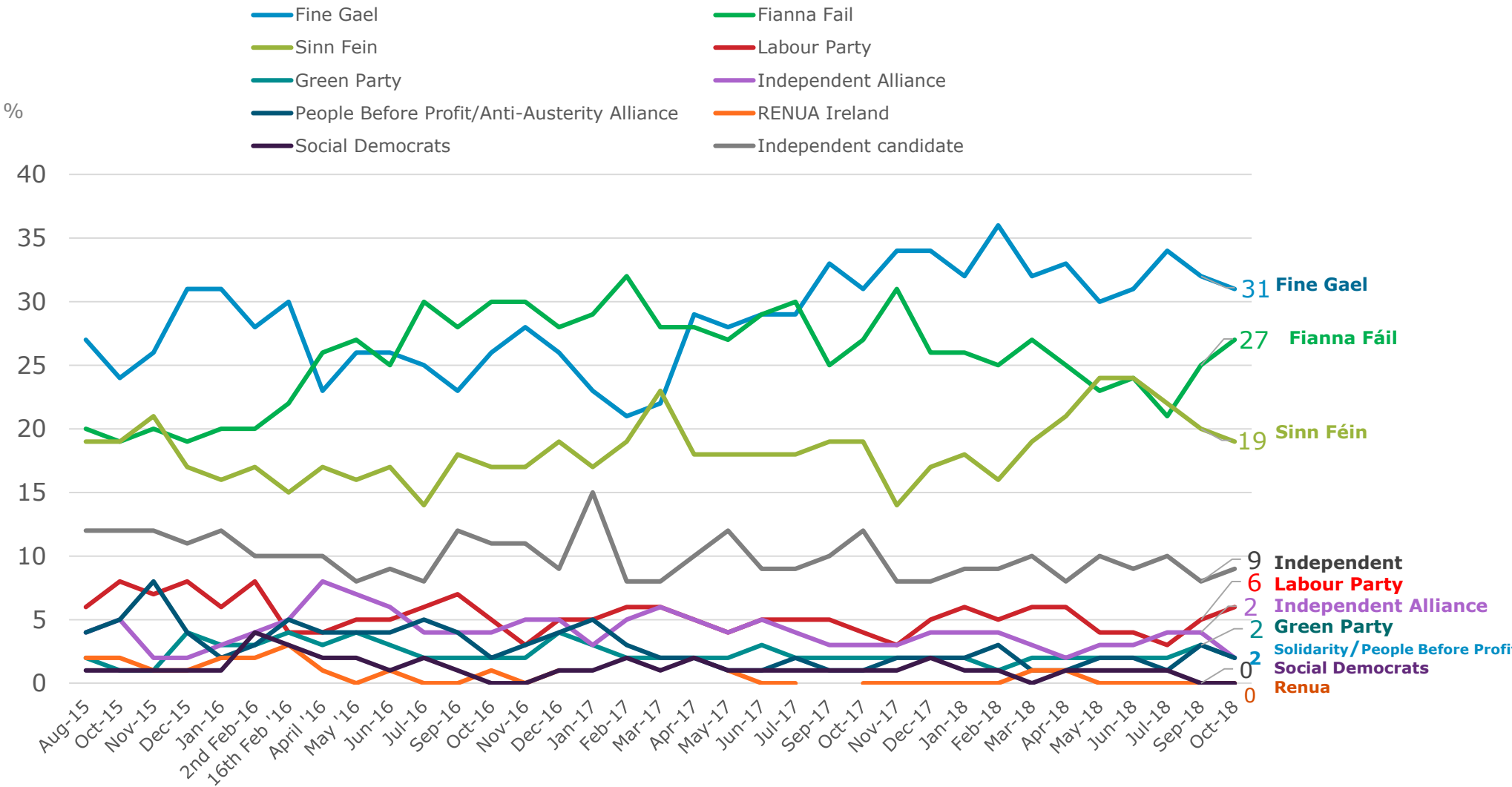
Party Support Levels - Detailed Breakdown

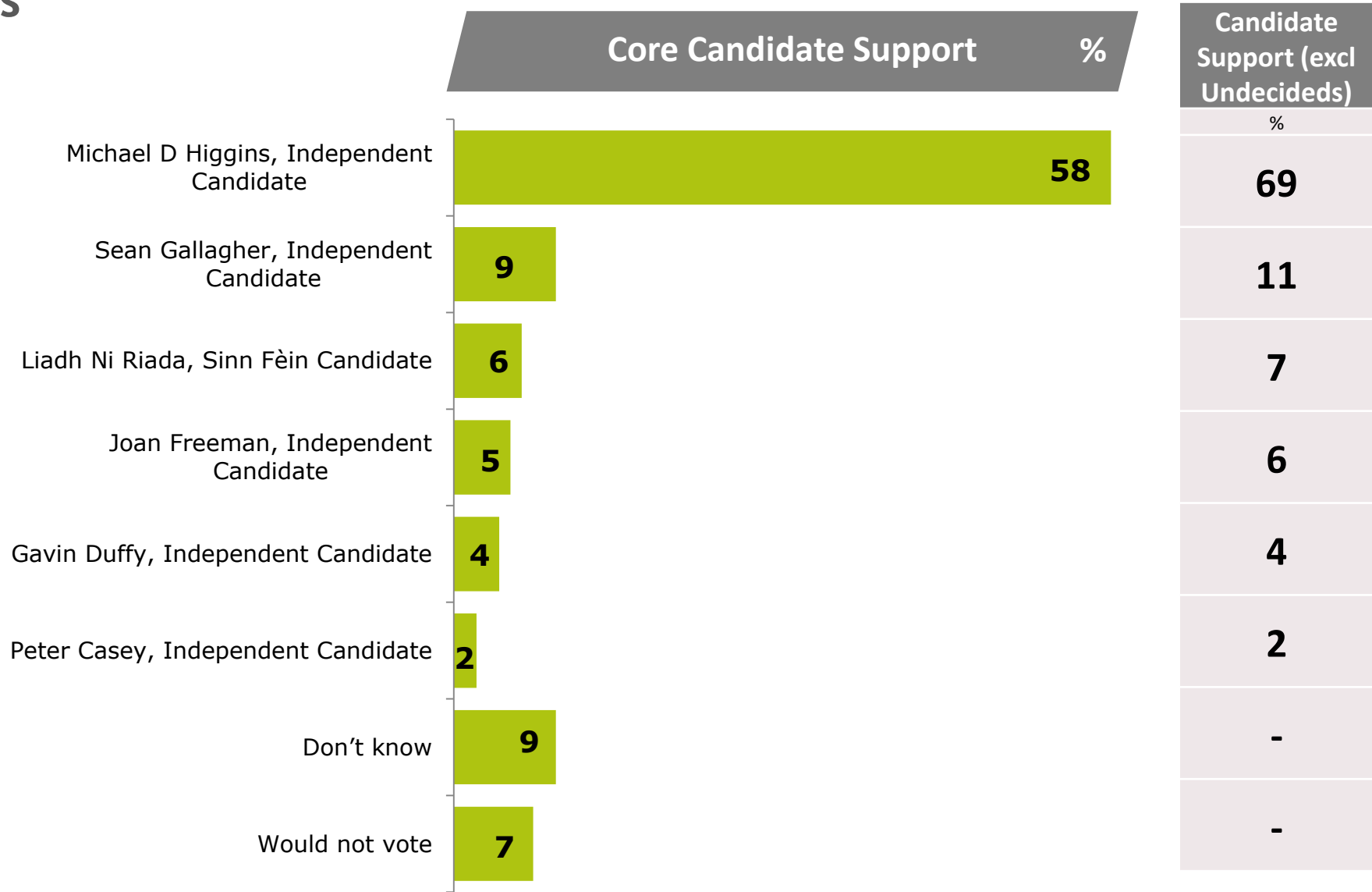

Commentary

Background

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Friday 5th to Tuesday 16th October.

As such, interviewing will have straddled the pre and post budget announcement period, with most fieldwork completed before Monday night's Claire Byrne Live TV Presidential debate, and well before the Virgin Media One TV debate with Pat Kenny.

People's general reaction to the budget seems to have been reasonably neutral, insofar as it confirms that the austerity era cycle of swingeing tax increases and expenditure cuts is truly over, albeit with personal tax cuts still some way off.

Apart from the budget, the domestic news story in the weeks leading up to today's poll has been the on-going Brexit negotiations, with Taoiseach Leo Varadkar and Simon Coveney appearing, in public at least, to hold the line in terms of the need for a guaranteed Irish border back stop agreement.

The Presidential Election campaign can hardly be described as scintillating thus far, and it is difficult to see how the performance of any of the six candidates could have influenced the public's opinion as to which political party to vote for at the next General Election. Today's poll measures the public support for party leaders and the political parties themselves, as well as voting intentions for next Friday's Presidential Election.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

Today's poll confirms yet again that Fine Gael is the most popular party in the country, with 31% of all potential voters indicating they would give the party their first preference vote in a General Election. This figure is on a par with the 32% registered for Fine Gael last month, and just one percentage point below its nine month 2018 average of 32%.

Fianna Fáil remains the second most popular party, with its support increasing by a statistically insignificant 2 percentage points to 27% today. This figure positions the party marginally ahead of its nine month 2018 average of 25% support, and closer to the levels of popularity it achieved in the first three or four months of this year.

In interpreting this quite consistent lead which Fine Gael has enjoyed over Fianna Fáil in the polls for the best part of a year, we might remind ourselves of the 2016 election.

During the course of that campaign, Fine Gael also held a comfortable lead over Fianna Fáil in the Opinion Polls, only for the gap to shrink to just over one percent on election day.

Whether this was down to historical 'latent' Fianna Fáil voters returning to the fold in the cold light of election day, or for some other reason, there is no doubt that Fianna Fáil has performed better in recent elections than the pre-election polls have indicated.

Closer analysis of today's poll findings suggest that this same trend could well unfold at the next election.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

For example, while support for Fine Gael is four percentage points greater than Fianna Fáil at a national level, the gap narrows the older the voter becomes, to the point where the parties are locked at 33% apiece amongst all of those aged 55 years plus. Given that older voters are more inclined to actually turn out on election day, there is certainly no guarantee that an election triggered by Fine Gael would guarantee their position as post-election king makers.

Sinn Féin then sits in third place overall at 19% support – a figure which swings quite dramatically from 31% support amongst 18-34 year olds to just 14% amongst older voters aged 55 years plus.

The party does, however, shunt Fine Gael into third position amongst blue collar working C2DE voters. Amongst this cohort, Fianna Fáil is actually in lead position with 34% support, followed by Sinn Féin on 25%, and Fine Gael on just 21%.

While a 19% share of the vote come election day would boost Sinn Féin's seat tally considerably, it is a fact that the party has not really benefited from the election of Mary Lou McDonald as leader, with many commentators questioning the wisdom of running a presidential candidate, and subsequently omitting any party branding from her election campaign material.

Another long term trend which is confirmed in this month's poll is that of the significant drop in support for Independents and smaller parties, from a share of 27.5% of the vote in the February 2016 election, to just 17% support in our last three polls.

Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels

A closer look at the figures illustrates that this quite precipitous drop is mainly accounted for by a decline in support for smaller parties and independent groupings such as Solidarity/People before Profit, the Social Democrats, the Independent Alliance and Reuna (which is of course no longer in existence).

The message here seems to be quite clear – many voters have become disillusioned over the last two years with the performance of smaller parties and groupings in the Dáil, and have drifted back to the larger parties, presumably as a means of seeking greater post-election stability.

Presidential Candidate Support

Earlier this year, Michael D. Higgins was prevaricating as to whether he would seek a second term in Áras an Uachtarain, having promised the nation seven years previously that he most definitely would not do so.

In the end, the widely held view that the most popular Irish President in recent times would most likely win the election in a landslide prompted him to throw his hat into the ring.

At the time, I was of the view that, once a range of suitably qualified candidates began to challenge Higgins during the course of a presidential election campaign, support for Higgins would begin to erode, albeit not to the extent that he would still not emerge victorious, most likely on the first count.

My theory at that time was based on the assumption that a reasonably credible line up of competitors would stand against the incumbent, and that perhaps one or two of them would capture the public's imagination and convince a significant proportion of the Electorate that a fresh, new voice in the Áras was worth voting for.

I had not taken into account in these ruminations the eventual line-up of candidates which ultimately emerged – surely the most unimpressive, if not pitiful, array of individuals ever to run for the office.

The result is a 69% first preference level of support for Michael D. Higgins in today's poll, once the 16% of undecided voters are excluded from the calculation.

In second position is Seán Gallagher on 11%, Liadh Ní Riada on 7%, Joan Freeman on 6%, Gavin Duffy at 4%, and Peter Casey coming up the rear at just 2%.

Presidential Candidate Support

Even if, as may well still happen, the likes of Gallagher, Ní Riada, and Freeman experience a late surge in support, it will not be enough to prevent Higgins being returned next Friday the 26th of October, on the first count.

Based on what has been a particularly low key and poor campaign from all six candidates, there may well of course be a particularly low turnout come election day, with only older, more committed establishment-type voters actually casting a ballot.

Even if this does transpire, Higgins cannot be beaten. His support remains above 60% across all of the main socio-demographic groupings, whether young or old, male or female, or urban versus rural based.

In other words, whatever the profile of voter that turns out for the election, Higgins will still win in a landslide.

Similarly, Higgins is the most popular candidate amongst supporters of all political parties and independent candidates – including Sinn Féin which is the only party actually running a candidate.

Furthermore, if by some quirk the election was to go to a second count on the morning of Saturday the 27th of October, our poll reveals that Higgins would still garner the greatest single share of second preference transfers from the other five candidates.

Finally, at this stage of the 2011 Presidential Election, just 17% of those polled by B&A indicated they would not be allocating a second preference vote to any candidate. In today's poll, 43% of all potential voters indicate that they would not allocate a second preference to any candidate – further proof that for a sizeable proportion of the population there is really only one candidate worth considering.
