## **Technical Appendix**



#### **Sample Size**

The results of this opinion poll are based upon a representative sample of 940 eligible Irish voters aged 18 years +.



#### **Fieldwork**

As such, the results can be deemed to be accurate to within plus or minus 3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. Fieldwork was conducted on an inhome, face-to-face basis over the period  $6^{th}$  –  $18^{th}$  Sept 2018.



#### Location

The sample was stratified across all constituencies at 125 locations in the country with individuals selected for interview by way of Demographic Quotas (age, gender, socio-economic status) in line with Central Statistics Office (CSO) and market research industry population estimates.





## Technical Appendix



#### Weighting

The subsequent survey results are weighted to reflect the known demographic profile of Irish adults, utilising the most recently published census population estimates from the Central Statistics Office (CSO).



#### **Party Support**

Party support levels are subsequently realigned in accordance with a technical adjustment factor, designed to smooth the effects of extreme highs and lows in support levels for individual parties as measured at a single point in time, and taking variable election day turnout levels into account.



#### **Guidelines**

All aspects of the survey, including the Party Support adjustment factor, are implemented in accordance with the technical and ethical guidelines set down by the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations (AIMRO) and the European Society of Opinion & Market Research (ESOMAR).

# Party Support Adjustment Factor: Technical Note

- Predicting election results on the basis of poll data is not an exact science. All the evidence shows that support for individual parties can swing dramatically in the period between elections- very often outside the bounds of historic election results.
- What to do in these circumstances? Most polling companies in Britain and Ireland publish their raw survey results as an index of fluctuations in the emotional mood of voters. They also build in an adjustment based on a number of factors. Where we have reports of how people voted in the last general election as well as how they intend to vote in the next one we can use these data to model the likely level of swing from the last election results.
- We then add back in the forecasts of voters who have not voted last time or do not answer that particular question.
- Finally we take into account each individuals stated likelihood of voting in a forthcoming General Election.
- This is the basis of the adjusted voting forecast in Behaviour & Attitudes polls.



(excluding undecided/adjusted)



### **Background**

Fieldwork for today's poll was conducted over the period Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> – Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2018.

It is the first Sunday Times/B&A Poll to be conducted since July, given that the Dáil has been in summer recess since then.

While the Dáil may not have been sitting in recent months, the socio-political landscape has nevertheless been extremely active, with voters' opinions as registered in today's poll likely to have been influenced by a whole confluence of factors.

Domestically, we have witnessed over the last number of weeks in particular quite frenetic activity in relation to the forthcoming presidential election. With the incumbent Michael D. Higgins signalling his intent to seek a second term in office as the preferred Fine Gael and Fianna Fáil candidate, we now have confirmation of Sinn Féin's candidate Liadh Ní Riada, as well as four independents – Sean Gallagher, Gavin Duffy, Joan Freeman and Peter Casey.

It will be interesting to see over the next number of weeks the extent to which Sean Gallagher can pick up significant levels of support from the Fianna Fáil 'genepool' support base, and whether the additional airtime that Sinn Féin will command on the airwaves will benefit the party's overall level of support.



#### **Background**

On the economic front, pre-budget conversations have already begun between Fine Gael and Fianna Fáil, with an expectation building amongst voters that there may be some, however minor, financial relief for the average worker and pensioner come budget day.

Any such creeping optimism around the economy has undoubtedly been tempered by concerns over the seemingly agonising Brexit negotiations. Neither side seems to be any closer to a breakthrough in this regard, with the very real prospect of significant damage to the Irish economy looming as we edge ever closer to the March 2019 end date.

Other high profile topics of interest in recent weeks have included the publication of the Scally report on the cervical check scandal, and the extent to which it revealed serious shortcomings in the Irish health service, and how female patients in particular have been treated over the years.

The housing crisis also continues as a source of social unrest, and in recent weeks has reached new levels of public demonstration and protest.



### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

As the Dáil broke up for the summer period, we saw satisfaction with the Government reach almost 50%, with the average Government rating over the six months running up to July standing at an impressive 47%.

This figure has dropped to 43% in September, although it should be noted that satisfaction with both the Government and all of the party leaders is down on July – potentially a feature of an unknown proportion of the electorate disengaging from politics in general over the summer period.

In terms of voter demographics, those most happy with the manner in which the Government is running the country include males (48%), 18-34 year olds (47%), ABC1 white collar and professional workers (50%), and farmers (59%).

Today's poll represents the one year anniversary of the inclusion of Leo Varadkar as Taoiseach in the series. Over that 12 month period, satisfaction with Varadkar's performance as Taoiseach has increased significantly from 49% in September 2017 to 53% today.

The Taoiseach's satisfaction has dipped by three percentage points to 53% in today's poll, and he is most popular amongst ABC1 voters (60%), farmers (58%), as well as those resident in the Greater Dublin Area (56%).

Micheál Martin's satisfaction as leader of Fianna Fáil remains reasonably steady at 48% this month compared to 49% in July. Martin's satisfaction is greatest in all areas outside Dublin, and across all socio demographic groupings with the exception of farmers, where his satisfaction stands at just 37%.



#### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

Mary Lou McDonald's popularity rating has increased from 46% in her first B&A poll last March to 50% today. This does represent a dip of 3 percentage points since July, and her popularity is quite evenly spread across all age groups and socio economic groupings – peaking at 52% satisfaction in urban areas and at 52% amongst female voters.

Brendan Howlin's general satisfaction since he was first measured in the polling series in July 2016 has remained reasonably consistent since then. Thus, his personal rating went from 43% in 2016 to 44% in September 2017, and 41% today.

Over three-quarters of core Labour Party supporters are happy with the job Howlin is doing as leader of the Labour Party, with the balance either dissatisfied or unsure.

In terms of party support, last July's poll registered Fianna Fáil's lowest level of popularity in more than two years, at just 21% nationwide.

In today's poll, the party has regained much of this lost ground, and at 25% support, the party could gain some additional seats in the next General Election, based on its 24% share of the vote in 2016.

An average of all of our polls conducted since January of this year illustrates a fairly solid 25% share of popular support for Fianna Fáil, compared to a comparable and consistent figure of 33% for Fine Gael.



#### **Party Support and Leader Satisfaction Levels**

Support for the Labour Party stands at 5% today, and an average of 5% for the year, indicating that the party could well under-perform on its 2016 General Election showing of 7% if there was a General Election in the immediate future.

Sinn Féin support has dipped insignificantly by 2 percentage points to 20% this month, and this compares to its average of 21% so far this year.

Yet again, support for Independents and smaller parties remains significantly lower than the 28% captured by the bloc at the last election, standing at just 17% this month.

All in all, therefore, the polls are telling us that party support levels have been remarkably consistent throughout 2018, and that if there was an election over the next two to three months, a coalition of Fine Gael, the Labour Party and perhaps the Green Party plus Independents would most likely form the next Government.

This is of course predicated on the assumption that an election precipitated by Fine Gael was deemed by the public to have been called in the national interest, rather than for self-serving, opportunistic reasons.
